

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1595 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 36-7-4-1210.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2008]: Sec. 1210.5. (a)
- 5 ADVISORY. As used in this section, "~~town~~" **"municipality"** refers to
- 6 the most populous ~~town~~ **municipality** in the jurisdiction of the plan
- 7 commission.
- 8 (b) ADVISORY. This section applies to a plan commission
- 9 operating under a joinder agreement:
- 10 (1) in a county having a population of more than one hundred
- 11 eighty thousand (180,000) but less than one hundred eighty-two
- 12 thousand seven hundred ninety (182,790); and
- 13 (2) containing:
- 14 (A) a township having a population of more than eighteen
- 15 thousand (18,000) but less than twenty-five thousand (25,000);
- 16 or
- 17 (B) a township having a population of more than nine
- 18 thousand (9,000) but less than fifteen thousand (15,000).
- 19 (c) ADVISORY. Notwithstanding section 1210 of this chapter, a
- 20 plan commission described in subsection (b) shall have nine (9)
- 21 members as follows:
- 22 ~~(1) Two (2) members of the town legislative body; to be appointed~~
- 23 ~~by the town executive for a one (1) year term:~~
- 24 ~~(2) Two (2) town residents who are not elected officials or town~~
- 25 ~~employees; to be appointed by the town executive for a four (4)~~
- 26 ~~year term:~~
- 27 ~~(3) One (1) member of the township board; to be appointed by the~~
- 28 ~~township executive for a one (1) year term:~~
- 29 ~~(4) Four (4) township residents who:~~
- 30 (A) are not residents of the town; and
- 31 (B) are not employees of the town or township;

- 1 to be appointed by the township executive with the approval of the
- 2 township legislative body for a four (4) year term.
- 3 (1) Four (4) members who are residents of the municipality,
- 4 to be appointed for four (4) year terms by the executive of the
- 5 municipality.
- 6 (2) Three (3) members who are residents of the municipality,
- 7 to be appointed for four (4) year terms by the legislative body
- 8 of the municipality.
- 9 (3) Two (2) members who are residents of the township, to be
- 10 appointed for four (4) year terms by the township executive
- 11 with the approval of the township legislative body.
- 12 (d) The joinder agreement expires if the municipality annexes
- 13 the entire area of a township described in subsection (b)(2).
- 14 (e) A joinder agreement under this section may be terminated
- 15 if:
- 16 (1) the municipality adopts an ordinance terminating the
- 17 joinder agreement;
- 18 (2) before adopting the ordinance under subdivision (1), the
- 19 municipality conducts a public hearing on the issue of
- 20 terminating the joinder agreement; and
- 21 (3) the executive of the municipality provides written notice to
- 22 the township executive of the township subject to the joinder
- 23 agreement that states the reason for the municipality's
- 24 termination of the joinder agreement."
- 25 Page 8, after line 26, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 26 "SECTION 7. [EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2007] (a) The terms
- 27 of office of plan commission members appointed under
- 28 IC 36-7-4-1210.5 before January 1, 2008, expire on December 31,
- 29 2007.
- 30 (b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2009."
- 31 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
