Synopsis: Holocaust education course. Beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, requires each school corporation to include a study of the Holocaust as a part of its curriculum.

Effective: July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-30-5-7, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
2 14, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
3 2007]: Sec. 7. Each school corporation shall include in the school

8 (C) composition;
9 (D) speech; and
10 (E) second languages.
11 (2) Mathematics.
12 (3) Social studies and citizenship, including the:

15 (C) histories;
16 of Indiana and the United States.
17 (4) Sciences.
