DIGEST OF SB 342 (Updated January 24, 2007 2:23 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 20-33.

Synopsis: School absence for civil air patrol activities. Requires a school governing body or administrative officer to excuse a student who is a member of the Indiana wing of the civil air patrol for not more than five absences per school year for certain emergency service operations, or for the duration of an international air cadet exchange program.

Effective: July 1, 2007.

SENATE BILL No. 342

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-33-2-17.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007]: **Sec. 17.2. The governing body of a**
4 **school corporation or the chief administrative officer of a**
5 **nonpublic school system shall authorize the absence and excuse of**
6 **each student who is a member of the Indiana wing of the civil air**
7 **patrol and who is participating in a civil air patrol:**
8 (1) **international air cadet exchange program, for the length**
9 **of the program; or**
10 (2) **emergency service operation, including:**
11 (A) **search and rescue missions designated by the Air Force**
12 **Rescue Coordination Center;**
13 (B) **disaster relief, when requested by the federal or state**
14 **emergency management agency;**
15 (C) **humanitarian services, when requested by the federal**
16 **or state emergency management agency;**
17 (D) **United States Air Force support designated by the First**

1 **Air Force, North American Aerospace Defense Command;**
2 **or**
3 **(E) United States Air Force military flights, if the flights**
4 **are not available on days when school is not in session;**
5 **for not more than five (5) days in a school year;**
6 **if the student submits to school authorities appropriate**
7 **documentation from the Indiana wing of the civil air patrol**
8 **detailing the reason for the student's absence. A student excused**
9 **from school attendance under this section may not be recorded as**
10 **being absent on any date to which the excuse applies and may not**
11 **be penalized by the school in any manner.**

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Education and Career Development, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 342, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, line 8, delete "aerospace education or" and insert **"international air"**.

Page 1, line 8, after "cadet" insert **"exchange program, for the length of the"**.

Page 1, line 10, delete "rescue;" and insert **"rescue missions designated by the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center;"**.

Page 1, line 11, delete "relief;" and insert **"relief, when requested by the federal or state emergency management agency;"**.

Page 1, line 12, delete "services; or" and insert **"services, when requested by the federal or state emergency management agency;"**.

Page 1, line 13, delete "support;" and insert **"support designated by the First Air Force, North American Aerospace Defense Command; or**

(E) United States Air Force military flights, if the flights are not available on days when school is not in session; for not more than five (5) days in a school year;".

Page 1, line 14, delete "for not more than five (5) days in a school year,".

Page 1, line 14, beginning with "if" begin a new line blocked left. and when so amended that said bill do pass.
