Summary of Legislation: This bill defines "rescue services provider" and specifies that reports of missing endangered adults may be given to rescue services providers. The bill also establishes the duties of rescue services providers upon receipt of a report of a missing endangered adult.

Effective Date: July 1, 2009.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: This bill adds rescue services providers as points of contact for reporting missing endangered adults. Rescue services providers include firefighters, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, physicians, and licensed nurses. Requiring rescue services providers to prepare investigative reports for missing endangered adults can increase workload of those providers that receive these reports.
