Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill: (1) requires the driver of a school bus to stop the school bus before crossing certain railroad tracks. (Current law requires the driver to stop only when carrying a passenger.); (2) authorizes an individual less than 18 years of age to operate a motor vehicle in which there are passengers if the licensed operator is accompanied by a parent, guardian, or stepparent of the operator who is: (A) not a licensed driver; (B) at least 21 years of age; and (C) present in the front seat of the motor vehicle.
