Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill:

(1) allows a person who drives an authorized emergency vehicle to execute a lawful intervention technique involving a fleeing motor vehicle if the person has completed a training course that instructs participants in the proper execution of lawful intervention techniques;
(2) requires the driver of a school bus to stop the school bus before crossing certain railroad tracks. (Current law requires the driver to stop only when carrying a passenger.); and
(3) authorizes an individual less than 18 years of age to operate a motor vehicle in which there are passengers if the licensed operator is accompanied by a parent, guardian, or stepparent of the operator.
