I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 249 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 motor vehicle fuel tax, transportation, motor vehicles, and tort claims
- 4 and to make an appropriation.
- 5 Page 17, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 21. IC 9-18-15-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.30-2008,
- 7 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 8 JULY 1, 2009]: Sec. 1. (a) A person who is the registered owner or
- 9 lessee of a:
- 10 (1) passenger motor vehicle;
- 11 (2) motorcycle;
- 12 (3) recreational vehicle; or
- 13 (4) vehicle registered as a truck with a declared gross weight of
- 14 not more than:
- 15 (A) eleven thousand (11,000) pounds;
- 16 (B) nine thousand (9,000) pounds; or
- 17 (C) seven thousand (7,000) pounds;
- 18 registered with the bureau or who makes an application for an original
- 19 registration or renewal registration of a vehicle may apply to the bureau
- 20 for a personalized license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for which
- 21 registration is sought instead of the regular license plate.
- 22 (b) A person who:
- 23 (1) is the registered owner or lessee of a vehicle described in
- 24 subsection (a); and

 43 may apply to the bureau for a personalized license plate to be affixed
 44 to the vehicle for which registration is sought instead of the regular
 45 special recognition license plate.
 46 SECTION 22. IC 9-18-56 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

1 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
2 JULY 1, 2009]:

3 **Chapter 56. Indiana Soldiers' and Sailors' Children's Home**
4 **Alumni Association License Plates**

5 **Sec. 1. The bureau shall design and issue an Indiana Soldiers'**
6 **and Sailors' Children's Home alumni association license plate. The**
7 **Indiana Soldiers' and Sailors' Children's Home alumni association**
8 **license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group**
9 **recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

10 **Sec. 2. After January 1, 2010, a person who is eligible to register**
11 **a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana Soldiers'**
12 **and Sailors' Children's Home alumni association license plate**
13 **under this chapter upon doing the following:**

14 (1) **Completing an application for an Indiana Soldiers' and**
15 **Sailors' Children's Home alumni association license plate.**

16 (2) **Paying the fees under section 3 of this chapter.**

17 **Sec. 3. (a) The fees for an Indiana Soldiers' and Sailors'**
18 **Children's Home alumni association license plate are as follows:**

19 (1) **The appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a).**

20 (2) **An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).**

21 (b) **The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
22 **collected by the bureau.**

23 (c) **The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
24 **deposited in the Indiana Soldiers' and Sailors' Children's Home**
25 **alumni association trust fund established by section 4 of this**
26 **chapter.**

27 **Sec. 4. (a) The Indiana Soldiers' and Sailors' Children's Home**
28 **alumni association trust fund (referred to as the "fund" in this**
29 **section) is established.**

30 (b) **The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
31 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**
32 **manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that**
33 **accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.**
34 **Money in the fund is continuously appropriated for the purposes**
35 **of this section.**

36 (c) **The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of**
37 **administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.**

38 (d) **On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute**
39 **the money from the fund to the Indiana Soldiers' and Sailors'**
40 **Children's Home alumni association.**

- 1 **(e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not**
- 2 **revert to the state general fund."**
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
