# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1585 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, after line 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 14-22-2-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 4 1, 2009]: **Sec. 9. The director shall allow a person who holds a**
- 5 **hunting license described in IC 14-22-12-1(12), IC 14-22-12-1(15),**
- 6 **IC 14-22-12-1(20), or IC 14-22-12-1(21) to hunt deer and turkey**
- 7 **using a crossbow during the same season that a person is allowed**
- 8 **to hunt deer or turkey using a shotgun or a rifle.**
- 9 SECTION 4. IC 14-22-12-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.66-2008,
- 10 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 11 JULY 1, 2009]: Sec. 1. (a) The department may issue the following
- 12 licenses and, except as provided in section 1.5 of this chapter and
- 13 subject to subsection (b), shall charge the following minimum license
- 14 fees to hunt, trap, or fish in Indiana:
- 15 (1) A resident yearly license to fish, eight dollars and seventy-five
- 16 cents (\$8.75).
- 17 (2) A resident yearly license to hunt, eight dollars and
- 18 seventy-five cents (\$8.75).
- 19 (3) A resident yearly license to hunt and fish, thirteen dollars and
- 20 seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 21 (4) A resident yearly license to trap, eight dollars and seventy-five
- 22 cents (\$8.75).
- 23 (5) A nonresident yearly license to fish, twenty-four dollars and
- 24 seventy-five cents (\$24.75).

- 1 (6) A nonresident yearly license to hunt, sixty dollars and  
2 seventy-five cents (\$60.75).
- 3 (7) A nonresident yearly license to trap, one hundred seventeen  
4 dollars and seventy-five cents (\$117.75). However, a license may  
5 not be issued to a resident of another state if that state does not  
6 give reciprocity rights to Indiana residents similar to those  
7 nonresident trapping privileges extended in Indiana.
- 8 (8) A resident or nonresident license to fish, including for trout  
9 and salmon, for one (1) day only, four dollars and seventy-five  
10 cents (\$4.75).
- 11 (9) A nonresident license to fish, excluding for trout and salmon,  
12 for seven (7) days only, twelve dollars and seventy-five cents  
13 (\$12.75).
- 14 (10) A nonresident license to hunt for five (5) consecutive days  
15 only, twenty-five dollars and seventy-five cents (\$25.75).
- 16 (11) A resident or nonresident yearly stamp to fish for trout and  
17 salmon, six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$6.75).
- 18 (12) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a shotgun,  
19 muzzle loading gun, rifle, ~~or~~ handgun, **or crossbow**, thirteen  
20 dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 21 (13) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a muzzle loading  
22 gun, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 23 (14) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a bow and  
24 arrow, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 25 (15) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a shotgun,  
26 muzzle loading gun, rifle, ~~or~~ handgun, **or crossbow**, one hundred  
27 twenty dollars and seventy-five cents (\$120.75).
- 28 (16) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a muzzle  
29 loading gun, one hundred twenty dollars and seventy-five cents  
30 (\$120.75).
- 31 (17) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a bow and  
32 arrow, one hundred twenty dollars and seventy-five cents  
33 (\$120.75).
- 34 (18) A resident license to take an extra deer by a means, in a  
35 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the  
36 department under IC 4-22-2, five dollars (\$5).
- 37 (19) A nonresident license to take an extra deer by a means, in a  
38 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the  
39 department under IC 4-22-2, ten dollars (\$10).
- 40 (20) A resident yearly license to take a turkey, fourteen dollars  
41 and seventy-five cents (\$14.75).
- 42 (21) A nonresident yearly license to take a turkey, one hundred  
43 fourteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$114.75). However, if the  
44 state of residence of the nonresident applicant requires that before  
45 a resident of Indiana may take turkey in that state the resident of  
46 Indiana must also purchase another license in addition to a

- 1 nonresident license to take turkey, the applicant must also  
2 purchase a nonresident yearly license to hunt under this section.
- 3 (22) A resident license to take an extra turkey by a means, in a  
4 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the  
5 department under IC 4-22-2, fourteen dollars and seventy-five  
6 cents (\$14.75).
- 7 (23) A nonresident license to take an extra turkey by a means, in  
8 a location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by  
9 the department under IC 4-22-2, one hundred fourteen dollars and  
10 seventy-five cents (\$114.75). However, if the state of residence of  
11 the nonresident applicant requires that before a resident of  
12 Indiana may take a turkey in that state the resident of Indiana  
13 must also purchase another license in addition to a nonresident  
14 license to take a turkey, the applicant must also purchase a  
15 nonresident yearly license to hunt under this section.
- 16 (24) A resident youth yearly consolidated license to hunt and fish,  
17 six dollars (\$6). This license is subject to the following:
- 18 (A) An applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.  
19 (B) The license is in lieu of the resident yearly license to hunt  
20 and fish and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits to  
21 hunt and fish for a specific species or by a specific means.
- 22 (25) A resident senior yearly license to fish, three dollars (\$3).  
23 This license is subject to the following:
- 24 (A) An applicant must be at least sixty-four (64) years of age  
25 and born after March 31, 1943.  
26 (B) The license is in lieu of the resident yearly license to fish  
27 and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits to fish for a  
28 specific species or by a specific means.
- 29 (26) A resident senior "fish for life" license, seventeen dollars  
30 (\$17). This license is subject to the following:
- 31 (A) An applicant must be at least sixty-four (64) years of age  
32 and must have been born after March 31, 1943.  
33 (B) The license applies each year for the remainder of the  
34 license holder's life.  
35 (C) The license is in lieu of the resident senior yearly license  
36 to fish and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits to fish  
37 for a specific species or by a specific means.

- 1 (b) The commission may set license fees to hunt, trap, or fish above
- 2 the minimum fees established under subsection (a).".
