A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-30-5.5-4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2009]: **Sec. 4. Every two (2) years, each superintendent shall file**
4 **for approval with the state superintendent a policy concerning safe**
5 **usage of the Internet by children.**

6 SECTION 2. IC 20-30-5.5-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
7 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
8 1, 2009]: **Sec. 5. On or before December 1, 2009, and biennially**
9 **thereafter, the state superintendent shall submit a report to the**
10 **legislative council summarizing the Internet usage policies filed**
11 **with the superintendent under this chapter and the status of those**
12 **policies. The report must be in an electronic format under**
13 **IC 5-14-6.**
