

SENATE BILL No. 89

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-34-2-4.5.

Synopsis: Physician admitting privileges. Requires a physician who performs an abortion to: (1) have admitting privileges at a hospital in the county or in a county adjacent to the county where the abortion is performed; and (2) notify the patient of the hospital location where the patient can receive follow-up care by the physician.

Effective: July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-34-2-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2009]: **Sec. 4.5. (a) A physician may not perform an abortion**
4 **unless the physician has admitting privileges at a hospital located:**
5 **(1) in the county; or**
6 **(2) in a county adjacent to the county;**
7 **in which the abortion is performed.**
8 **(b) A physician who performs an abortion shall notify the**
9 **patient of the location of the hospital at which the physician has**
10 **privileges and where the patient may receive follow-up care by the**
11 **physician if complications arise.**
