
HOUSE BILL No. 1605

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-7-13.5-19.

Synopsis: Money transfer from marina development commission. Requires the Lake Michigan marina development commission to return to the state general fund any unexpended or unencumbered balance of a state appropriation to the commission. Establishes the commission account within the shoreline environmental trust fund, and appropriates the balance recovered from the Lake Michigan marina development commission to the commission account to fund the operations of the shoreline development commission.

Effective: Upon passage.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1605



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-7-13.5-19 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 19. (a) The
 3 shoreline environmental trust fund is established to provide a source of
 4 money for the following:

- 5 (1) The rehabilitation, redevelopment, and reuse of qualifying
 6 property by providing grants to political subdivisions to conduct
 7 any of the following activities:
 - 8 (A) Identification and acquisition of qualifying property within
 9 a political subdivision.
 - 10 (B) Environmental assessment of identified qualifying
 11 property and other activities necessary or convenient to
 12 complete the environmental assessments.
 - 13 (C) Remediation of environmental contamination conducted
 14 on qualifying property.
 - 15 (D) Clearance of real property under IC 36-7-14-12.2 or
 16 IC 36-7-15.1-7 in connection with remediation activities.
 - 17 (E) Other activities necessary or convenient to return qualified



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property to full use.

(2) The operations of the commission.

(b) The commission account is established within the shoreline environmental trust fund to provide money for the operations of the commission.

SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The Lake Michigan marina development commission established by IC 14-13-3-3 shall before July 1, 2009, return to the state general fund any unexpended or unencumbered balance as of the effective date of this SECTION of a state appropriation to the commission, regardless of when the state appropriation was made.**

(b) The amount of the balance recovered under subsection (a) is appropriated for the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, and ending June 30, 2009, from the state general fund to the commission account established for the shoreline development commission by IC 36-7-13.5-19(b), as added by this act.

(c) This SECTION expires January 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**

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
