Citations Affected: IC 21-12.

Synopsis: Information on individual development accounts. Requires a caseworker of a foster child to provide information to the child and the child's foster parent concerning individual development accounts.

Effective: July 1, 2010.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 389

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 5 (b) A caseworker (as defined in IC 31-9-2-11) shall provide each
- 6 student to whom the caseworker is assigned information concerning the
- 7 program at the appropriate time for the student to receive the
- 8 information, shall explain the program to the student, and shall provide
- 9 the student with information concerning:
- 10 (1) Pell grants;
- 11 (2) Chafee grants;
- 12 (3) federal supplemental grants;
- 13 (4) the Free Application for Federal Student Aid; ~~and~~
- 14 (5) **individual development accounts (as described under**
- 15 **IC 4-4-28); and**
- 16 ~~(5)~~ (6) the state student assistance commission.
- 17 (c) A student who receives information under this section shall sign

A caseworker (as defined in IC 31-9-2-11) shall provide each foster parent of a student described in section 5(b) of this chapter to whom the caseworker is assigned information concerning individual development accounts (as described under IC 4-4-28).**".
