Citations Affected: IC 8-23.

Synopsis: Complete streets guidelines. Beginning December 2010, requires the Indiana department of transportation (INDOT) to report annually in an electronic format to the general assembly on the steps taken and progress made by INDOT in developing and implementing complete streets guidelines at the state level.

Effective: July 1, 2010.

HOUSE BILL No. 1182

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 8-23-9-59 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2010]: **Sec. 59. (a) As used in this section, "complete street"**
4 **means a highway, street, or other roadway that is designed and**
5 **operated to enable safe, comfortable, and convenient access for all**
6 **users, regardless of age or ability.**
7 **(b) As used in this section, "user" means a motorist, pedestrian,**
8 **bicyclist, or transit passenger.**
9 **(c) Not later than December 1 of each year, the department shall**
10 **report in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 to the general**
11 **assembly on the steps taken and the progress made by the**
12 **department in developing and implementing complete street**
13 **guidelines at the state level.**
