MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Veterans Affairs and Public Safety, to which was referred Senate Bill 102, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 public safety.
- 4 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 5 paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 1. IC 10-17-12-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 7 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 8 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010]: **Sec. 4.5. As used in this chapter,**
- 9 **"designated period" refers to active duty service:**
- 10 **(1) during a time of war or national conflict; or**
- 11 **(2) upon the call of the President of the United States or the**
- 12 **governor:**
- 13 **(A) for a national or state emergency;**
- 14 **(B) to provide humanitarian assistance; or**

1 **(C) for peacekeeping operations.**

2 SECTION 2. IC 10-17-12-7.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.50-2009,
3 SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 7.5. As used in this chapter, "qualified service
5 member" means an individual who is:

- 6 (1) an Indiana resident;
7 (2) a member of:
8 (A) the armed forces; or
9 (B) the National Guard; and
10 (3) serving on active duty:
11 (A) after September 11, 2001; and
12 ~~(B) during a time of national conflict or war.~~

13 **(B) during a designated period.**

14 SECTION 3. IC 10-17-12-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.50-2009,
15 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
16 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 8. (a) The military family relief fund is established
17 to provide assistance with food, housing, utilities, medical services,
18 basic transportation, child care, education, employment or workforce,
19 and other essential family support expenses that have become difficult
20 to afford for qualified service members or dependents of qualified
21 service members.

22 (b) Except as provided in section 9 of this chapter, the board shall
23 expend the money in the fund exclusively to provide grants for
24 assistance as described in subsection (a).

25 (c) A qualified service member or the qualified service member's
26 dependent may be eligible to receive assistance from the fund for up to
27 one (1) year after the earlier of the following:

- 28 (1) the date the qualified service member's active duty service
29 ends.
30 (2) The date, as established by ~~presidential proclamation the~~
31 **President of the United States, the governor**, or by law, of the
32 cessation of the ~~national conflict or war~~ **designated period** with
33 respect to which the qualified service member is eligible to
34 receive assistance under section 7.5(3)(B) of this chapter.

35 (d) The board shall administer the fund.

36 SECTION 4. IC 10-17-13-10, AS AMENDED BY P.L.50-2009,
37 SECTION 9, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
38 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 10. (a) The board shall manage and develop the

- 1 fund and the assets of the fund.
- 2 (b) The board shall do the following:
- 3 (1) Establish a policy for the investment of the assets of the fund.
- 4 In establishing a policy under this subdivision, the board shall:
- 5 (A) establish adequate long term financial goals for the fund;
- 6 and
- 7 (B) provide adequate funding for the military family relief
- 8 fund established by IC 10-17-12-8. ~~during a time of war or~~
- 9 ~~national conflict.~~
- 10 (2) Acquire money for the fund through the solicitation of private
- 11 or public donations and other revenue producing activities.
- 12 (3) Perform other tasks consistent with prudent management and
- 13 development of the fund."
- 14 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
