Your Committee on Commerce, Energy, Technology and Utilities, to which was referred House Bill 1094, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 4, delete "and (d)" and insert "**through (e)**".
- 2 Page 1, line 15, delete "facility with" and insert "**system that is**
- 3 **sized to meet all or part of a customer's electric load.**".
- 4 Page 1, delete lines 16 through 18.
- 5 Page 2, delete lines 1 through 14.
- 6 Page 2, line 23, delete "Microturbines" and insert "**Combustion**
- 7 **technology**".
- 8 Page 2, line 23, delete "fuels." and insert "**fuels or natural gas.**".
- 9 Page 2, line 25, delete "digestion." and insert "**digestion and algae**
- 10 **production systems.**".
- 11 Page 2, line 26, delete "landfills." and insert "**landfills or other**
- 12 **waste products.**".
- 13 Page 2, between lines 26 and 27, begin a new line double block
- 14 indented and insert:
- 15 "**(I) Combined heat and power systems that achieve at least**
- 16 **seventy percent (70%) overall efficiency.**"

- 1 **(4) Allow for customer meter aggregation."**
 - 2 Page 2, between lines 26 and 27, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 - 3 **"(c) A rule adopted by the commission under subsection (b) may**
 - 4 **not make the net metering and interconnection rules adopted by**
 - 5 **the commission and codified at 170 IAC 4-4.2 and 170 IAC 4-4.3**
 - 6 **apply to any of the following:**
 - 7 **(1) A cooperatively owned power supplier (as defined in**
 - 8 **IC 8-1-13.1-3).**
 - 9 **(2) A municipally owned utility (as defined in IC 8-1-2-1(h))."**
 - 10 Page 2, line 27, delete "(c)" and insert "**(d)**".
 - 11 Page 2, line 32, delete "(d)" and insert "**(e)**".
 - 12 Page 3, line 2, delete "(e)" and insert "**(f)**".
 - 13 Page 3, line 4, delete "(c)(1)" and insert "**(d)(1)**".
 - 14 Page 3, line 8, delete "(f)" and insert "**(g)**".
