Your Committee on Courts and Criminal Code, to which was referred House Bill 1258, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 10, delete "one (1)" and insert "**two (2)**".
- 2 Page 1, line 17, after "reproduction." insert "**The term does not**
- 3 **include an animal shelter or an animal rescue operation (as defined**
- 4 **in IC 15-21-1-1)**".
- 5 Page 2, line 3, delete "," and insert "**or upon request,**".
- 6 Page 2, line 3, after "offer" insert "**or request**".
- 7 Page 2, line 39, delete "or more" and insert "**to 99**".
- 8 Page 2, line 40, delete """, begin a new line double block indented
- 9 and insert:
- 10 "**(E) 100 to 249 litters during the one-year period preceding**
- 11 **the day this dog or cat was born.**
- 12 **(F) 250 to 499 litters during the one-year period preceding**
- 13 **the day this dog or cat was born.**
- 14 **(G) 500 to 1,000 litters during the one-year period**
- 15 **preceding the day this dog or cat was born.**
- 16 **(H) More than 1,000 litters during the one-year period**

- 1 **preceding the day this dog or cat was born."".**
- 2 Page 3, line 4, delete "and business address".
- 3 Page 3, line 6, delete "and business address".
- 4 Page 3, delete lines 12 through 23.
- 5 Page 3, delete lines 29 through 42.
- 6 Page 4, delete lines 1 through 28.
- 7 Page 6, between lines 23 and 24, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 8 "SECTION 4. IC 35-46-3-16 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 9 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY**
- 10 **1, 2010]: Sec. 16. (a) As used in this section, "equine" has the**
- 11 **meaning set forth in IC 34-6-2-40.**
- 12 **(b) A person having care or custody of an equine shall provide**
- 13 **the equine with access to shelter (including trees or other natural**
- 14 **barriers providing shelter) that provides protection from weather**
- 15 **extremes and that is free from standing water.**
- 16 **(c) A person who knowingly or intentionally violates subsection**
- 17 **(b) commits a Class B infraction. However, the offense is a Class A**
- 18 **infraction if the person has at least two (2) prior unrelated**
- 19 **judgments for violations of this section."**
- 20 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1258 as introduced.)
