MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Interstate and International Cooperation, to which was referred House Bill 1198, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 15 through 17, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 **"(d) Evidence that a person:**
- 4 **(1) acquired a motor vehicle by lease;**
- 5 **(2) signed a written agreement to return the motor vehicle to**
- 6 **a specified location within a specified time; and**
- 7 **(3) failed to return the motor vehicle:**
- 8 **(A) within twenty-one (21) days after the specified time; or**
- 9 **(B) within five (5) days after a written demand for return**
- 10 **of the motor vehicle was either:**
- 11 **(i) personally served on the person; or**
- 12 **(ii) sent by registered mail to the person's address that**
- 13 **was provided by the person in the written agreement;**
- 14 **constitutes prima facie evidence that the person knowingly or**

1 intentionally exerted unauthorized control over property of
2 another person.

3 SECTION 2. IC 36-8-23 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
4 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
5 1, 2010]:

6 **Chapter 23. Report of Stolen or Unreturned Leased Motor**
7 **Vehicle**

8 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "local law enforcement agency"**
9 **means the department or agency of a city, town, or county whose**
10 **principal function is the apprehension of criminal offenders.**

11 **Sec. 2. A local law enforcement agency that receives a report,**
12 **warrant, or other reliable information stating that a rental, for**
13 **hire, or leased motor vehicle:**

14 (1) has been stolen; or

15 (2) has not been returned as set forth in IC 35-43-4-3(d);

16 shall immediately report the theft of, or failure to return, the
17 motor vehicle to the National Crime Information Center.

18 **Sec. 3. A local law enforcement agency that receives information**
19 **concerning the recovery of a motor vehicle that the agency**
20 **previously reported as stolen or not returned shall immediately**
21 **report the recovery to the National Crime Information Center. The**
22 **agency shall also attempt to notify the reporting party of the**
23 **location and condition of the recovered motor vehicle by telephone,**
24 **if the telephone number of the reporting party is available or**
25 **readily accessible."**
