### MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development*, to which was referred House Bill 1230, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 7, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 **"(e) The director and the director's designees shall become**
- 3 **members of the national grain regulatory organization and shall:**
- 4 **(1) work in partnership with other state grain regulatory**
- 5 **officials;**
- 6 **(2) participate in national grain regulatory meetings; and**
- 7 **(3) provide expertise and education at national meetings."**
- 8 Page 8, line 16, strike "and" and insert "**or**".
- 9 Page 16, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 10 "SECTION 12. IC 26-4-1-23 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 11 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 23. "Warehouse"
- 12 means:
- 13 (1) any building or buildings or other protected enclosures in one
- 14 (1) general location licensed under IC 26-3-7 in which grain:
- 15 (A) may be stored for hire; or
- 16 (B) is used for grain bank storage; and

1 that is operated under one (1) ownership and run from a single  
2 office; or

3 (2) any facility licensed under the United States Warehouse Act.

4 **means any building or other protected enclosure in one (1) general**  
5 **location that is licensed or required to be licensed under IC 26-3-7**  
6 **in which grain is or may be:**

7 (1) stored for hire;

8 (2) used for grain bank storage; or

9 (3) used to store company owned grain;

10 **and the building or other protected enclosure is operated under**  
11 **one (1) ownership and run from a single office."**

12 Page 16, delete lines 28 through 33, begin a new paragraph and  
13 insert:

14 "SECTION 13. IC 26-4-1-24 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
15 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 24. ~~"Warehouseman"~~  
16 means a person engaged in the business of operating a warehouse for  
17 storing, shipping, or handling grain for hire that holds a valid  
18 warehouseman's license under IC 26-3-7 or the United States  
19 Warehouse Act. "Warehouse operator" means a person who  
20 operates a facility or group of facilities:

21 (1) in which grain is or may be stored for hire; or

22 (2) that is used for grain bank storage;

23 **and that is operated under one (1) ownership and run from a single**  
24 **office that holds a valid license under IC 26-3-7 or the United**  
25 **States Warehouse Act."**

26 Page 17, line 23, strike "valid".

27 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.

(Reference is to HB 1230 as introduced.)
