## HOUSE BILL No. 1162

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning special relief for David L. Scott and to make an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010] (a) There is  
2 appropriated to David L. Scott, who was released from prison in  
3 January 2008 after DNA evidence indicated he did not commit the  
4 murder for which he was convicted in April 1985, one hundred  
5 thousand dollars (\$100,000) from the state general fund for special  
6 relief. This money is not appropriated for payment of damages but  
7 is provided solely out of humanitarian consideration for the  
8 wrongs done to David L. Scott.

9 (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2011.
