

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 1 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 19, between lines 7 and 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 2 "SECTION 22. IC 4-31-11-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 3. The commission may
 4 establish a separate breed development advisory committee for each
 5 breed of horse, **except for standardbred horses**, that participates in
 6 racing meetings under this article."

7 Page 50, between lines 7 and 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 8 "SECTION 43. IC 15-19-2-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2008,
 9 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 10 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "board" refers to the
 11 Indiana standardbred advisory **and breed development** board
 12 established by section 2 of this chapter.

13 SECTION 44. IC 15-19-2-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2008,
 14 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 15 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 2. The Indiana standardbred advisory **and breed**
 16 **development** board is established to make recommendations to the
 17 Indiana horse racing commission (IC 4-31-3-1) for the furtherance of
 18 the standardbred horse industry in Indiana.

19 SECTION 45. IC 15-19-2-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2008,
 20 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 21 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 3. The ~~Indiana standardbred advisory~~ board
 22 consists of seven (7) members selected as follows:

- 23 (1) The chairman of the Indiana horse racing commission, or the
 24 chairman's designee, is an ex officio member.
- 25 (2) Two (2) members who are members of county fair boards
 26 appointed by the governor.
- 27 (3) Four (4) members appointed by the governor who have in the
 28 past participated or shown an interest in the standardbred
 29 industry. This interest may, but does not necessarily have to be,
 30 evidenced by virtue of being an owner, driver, veterinarian,
 31 trainer, or breeder.

1 Not more than three (3) of the appointees under subdivisions (2) and
 2 (3) may be of the same political party as the chairman of the Indiana
 3 horse racing commission.

4 SECTION 46. IC 15-19-2-5, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2008,
 5 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 6 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 5. (a) The ~~advisory~~ board shall elect a chairperson,
 7 a vice chairperson, a treasurer, and other officers the board considers
 8 necessary. The chairman of the Indiana horse racing commission serves
 9 as secretary and is entitled to vote on all matters.

10 (b) The records of the board shall be kept by the Indiana horse
 11 racing commission.

12 (c) The office of the board must be at the same location as the
 13 offices of the Indiana horse racing commission.

14 SECTION 47. IC 15-19-2-10, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2008,
 15 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 16 JULY 1, 2010]: Sec. 10. (a) The standardbred horse fund is established.

17 (b) The money received by the Indiana horse racing commission
 18 under this chapter shall be deposited in the standardbred horse fund.
 19 The standardbred horse fund is a nonbudgetary fund. Money remaining
 20 in the standardbred horse fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not
 21 revert to the state general fund.

22 (c) After considering the recommendations of the ~~advisory~~ board,
 23 the Indiana horse racing commission may disburse money from the
 24 standardbred horse fund for any purpose described in section 8 of this
 25 chapter.

26 (d) The Indiana horse racing commission shall pay any expense
 27 incurred in administering this chapter from the standardbred horse
 28 fund."

31 Page 62, delete line 4.

32 Page 62, line 5, delete "IC 4-31-11-6; IC 4-31-11-7; IC 4-31-11-8;".
