MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1109 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 16, line 13, delete "may not" and insert "**shall**".
- 2 Page 16, line 13, delete "until" and insert "**using the procedures in**
- 3 **IC 3-11.5 for counting absentee ballots at a central location,**
- 4 **including the procedures for challenging absentee ballots and**
- 5 **eliminating the absentee ballots of individuals voting in person at**
- 6 **the polls,".**
- 7 Page 16, delete line 14.
- 8 Page 16, line 15, delete "with the records on the direct record
- 9 electronic voting system".
- 10 Page 18, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 11 "SECTION 26. IC 3-11.5-1-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 12 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 4. To the extent
- 13 that they are in conflict with this article, the following statutes do not
- 14 apply to a county that has adopted a resolution described by section 1
