DIGEST OF HB 1343 (Updated March 8, 2011 10:17 am - DI 116)

Citations Affected: IC 6-6.

Synopsis: Lake and river enhancement fund. Allows money in the lake and river enhancement fund to be used in projects such as sediment removal, control of exotic or invasive plants or animals, or removal of logjams or obstructions.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1343

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 6-6-11-12.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 12.5. (a) The lake and
3 river enhancement fund is established and allocated for the following
4 purposes:

5 (1) One-half (1/2) of the fund shall be used to pay costs incurred
6 by the department of natural resources in implementing the lake
7 and river enhancement projects required by IC 14-32-7-12(b)(7).

8 (2) One-half (1/2) of the fund shall be used by the department of
9 natural resources to pay for **lake or river (as defined in**
10 **IC 14-32-7-12) projects, including, but not limited to, projects**
11 **to:**

- 12 (A) **remove sediment;**
13 (B) **control exotic or invasive plants or animals; or**
14 (C) **remove logjams or obstructions.**

15 **For purposes of this subdivision, the fund may not be used for**
16 **projects relating to a manmade ditch or waterway.**

 10 (e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert

 13 money in the fund allocated under subsection (a)(1) may be used to
 14 augment and supplement the funds appropriated for the implementation
 15 of lake and river enhancement projects required by
 16 IC 14-32-7-12(b)(7).

(A) remove sediment;

(B) control exotic or invasive plants or animals; or

(C) remove logjams or obstructions."

Page 1, delete line 10.

Page 1, line 11, delete "(B)".

Page 1, line 11, strike "Lake projects, including projects to:".

Page 1, line 12, delete "(i)".

Page 1, line 12, strike "remove sediment; or".

Page 1, line 13, delete "(ii)".

Page 1, line 13, strike "control exotic or invasive plants or animals.".
