Summary of Legislation: This bill creates the Hoosier Commission for Communities for a Lifetime. The bill requires the Commission to submit certain reports to the General Assembly.

(The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the Health Finance Commission.)

Effective Date: Upon passage.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill will increase the workload of the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) to provide staffing for the Commission. The Commission is required to provide the General Assembly with a preliminary report by November 2011 and a final report by November 2012.

Under the provisions of the bill, members of the Commission are not entitled to per diem or travel reimbursement. Any expenditures of the Commission are to come from appropriations already made to the IHCDA. This bill will not result in any new state appropriations. However, given that the IHCDA must divert funding to the Commission, there may be decreases in resources for other programs operated by the IHCDA.
