Summary of Legislation: This bill establishes the Commendation for Valor license plate. It specifies that an individual is eligible to receive a plate by: (1) presenting certification to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) from the United States Department of Defense that the individual is the recipient of a medal or commendation for valor while serving in the United States Armed Forces; and (2) paying a certain fee for the plate.

Effective Date: July 1, 2011.

Explanation of State Expenditures: PEN PRODUCTS, the manufacturing arm of prison-made products, will charge the BMV \$3.69 per plate if the plate is a multi-color plate, \$3.19 per plate for a truck plate and other one-color plates, or \$3.55 for a standard plate. The funds affected are the PEN PRODUCTS Revolving Fund and the Motor Vehicle Highway Account (MVHA), which supports the BMV.

There is no fee in addition to the regular registration fee for the plate. It is unknown at this time the number of individuals who might qualify to purchase the new license plate.

The proposal provides for the Commendation for Valor license plate to be a personalized license plate if the purchaser so decides. The fee for a PLP is \$48, with \$37 to the State License Branch Fund, \$7 is deposited into the Motor Vehicle Highway Account (MVHA), and \$4 is deposited into the Crossroads 2000 Fund.

MVHA-

- (1) Construction, reconstruction, and maintenance
- (2) Purchase of rental and repair of highway equipment
- (3) Painting of bridges
- (4) Land acquisition
- (5) Construction of storage buildings

Crossroads 2000-

- (1) Highway bonding projects

- (1) Operation of license branches throughout the state
