Summary of Legislation: This bill requires an applicant for an initial teaching license to be trained and certified in the use of an automated external defibrillator. It requires, after June 30, 2012, an applicant for the renewal of a teaching license to complete training and obtain certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, removing a foreign body causing an obstruction in an airway, the Heimlich maneuver, and the use of an automated external defibrillator.

Effective Date: July 1, 2011.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: Under current law, an applicant for an initial teaching license must be certified in CPR and the Heimlich maneuver. Under this bill, after June 30, 2011, the applicant must also be certified in the use of an automated external defibrillator. Additionally, after June 30, 2012, any applicant renewing a teaching license must meet the same guidelines as an applicant for an initial license. This bill does not apply to substitute teachers.

The impact of this proposal on school corporations would depend on whether an otherwise qualified individual renewing a teaching license is unable to complete the requirements of this bill. The impact is expected to be minimal.
