I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 1 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 4. IC 20-19-2-2, AS ADDED BY P.L. 1-2005, SECTION
3 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
4 2011]: Sec. 2. (a) The Indiana state board of education is established.
5 The state board consists of:
6 (1) the state superintendent; and
7 (2) ~~ten (10)~~ **nine (9) voting** members appointed by the governor.
8 **The state superintendent may make recommendations to the**
9 **governor as to the appointment of members to the state board. The**
10 **state superintendent shall serve as an ex officio voting member of**
11 **the state board.**
12 (b) The following provisions apply to members of the state board
13 appointed by the governor:
14 (1) ~~At least four (4) of the members~~ **Each member** must be
15 actively employed in the schools in Indiana and hold a valid
16 teaching license **in one (1) or more of the certification areas**
17 **listed in subdivision (2).**
18 (2) ~~At least one (1) member~~ **six (6) of the nine (9) appointed**
19 **members** must be ~~appointed from each congressional district in~~
20 ~~Indiana:~~ **practicing teachers. One (1) member must be actively**
21 **employed as a teacher education professional. One (1)**
22 **member must be a parent with a child enrolled in a public**
23 **elementary or secondary school in Indiana. Two (2) members**
24 **may also be administrators, with one (1) being a principal and**

1 **one (1) being a superintendent. At least one (1) of the**
 2 **members who are administrators must hold a certification**
 3 **and be actively employed in elementary education or in early**
 4 **childhood education and the other must hold a teacher**
 5 **certification in one (1) of the other certification areas, as**
 6 **follows:**

- 7 **(A) Special education.**
 8 **(B) Career and technical education.**
 9 **(C) Student services, which may include a school librarian**
 10 **or psychometric evaluator.**
 11 **(D) Social science education.**
 12 **(E) English or language arts education.**
 13 **(F) Math or science education.**
 14 **(G) Elementary or early childhood education.**
 15 **(H) Fine arts education.**

16 (3) Not more than ~~six (6)~~ **five (5)** members of the state board may
 17 be appointed from the membership of any one (1) political party.

18 (4) The term of office of a member begins on July 1. Except as
 19 provided in subdivision (5), the term of office of a member is four
 20 (4) years.

21 (5) The governor may dismiss a member for just cause.

22 (6) The governor may appoint a member to fill a vacancy
 23 occurring on the state board. A member appointed under this
 24 subdivision serves for the remainder of the unexpired term.

25 (c) A quorum consists of six (6) members of the state board. An
 26 action of the state board is not official unless the action is authorized
 27 by at least six (6) members.

28 ~~(d) The state superintendent serves as chairperson of the state~~
 29 ~~board."~~
