# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 1 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 35, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 38. IC 20-28-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2011]:
- 5 **Chapter 13. National Board Certification Incentives**
- 6 **Sec. 1. The general assembly establishes a goal that by 2025**
- 7 **there will be at least one (1) national board certified teacher in**
- 8 **every public school.**
- 9 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "fund" refers to the teachers'**
- 10 **national board certification incentive fund established by section**
- 11 **6 of this chapter.**
- 12 **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "mentor" means a highly skilled,**
- 13 **experienced teacher who provides systematic and ongoing support**
- 14 **and assistance to other teachers in a school or school corporation**
- 15 **to help them improve their teaching skills and practices.**
- 16 **Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "national board" refers to the**
- 17 **National Board for Professional Teaching Standards, a**
- 18 **nonpartisan, independent, and nonprofit board composed of**
- 19 **teachers and others that:**
- 20 **(1) has developed a set of standards for teachers; and**
- 21 **(2) operates a national voluntary system to assess and certify**
- 22 **teachers who meet the board's standards.**
- 23 **Sec. 5. As used in this chapter, "national board certification"**
- 24 **means a demonstration by an experienced teacher of the teacher's**

1 teaching practice as measured against the standards of the national  
2 board through an assessment process administered by the national  
3 board.

4 **Sec. 6. (a) The teachers' national board certification incentive**  
5 **fund is established for the following purposes:**

6 (1) Providing a scholarship to assist the teacher with the  
7 certification fee under section 7 of this chapter to each teacher  
8 who is awarded national board certification.

9 (2) Funding stipends under section 8 of this chapter for  
10 national board certified teachers who serve as mentors to  
11 other teachers within the school corporation.

12 (3) Reimbursing school corporations under section 9 of this  
13 chapter for salary supplements paid to national board  
14 certified teachers.

15 (b) The department shall administer the fund.

16 (c) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from  
17 money in the fund. The treasurer of state shall invest the money in  
18 the fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund  
19 in the same manner as other public money may be invested.  
20 Interest that accrues from these investments shall be deposited in  
21 the fund.

22 (d) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not  
23 revert to the state general fund.

24 **Sec. 7. A teacher who pays the initial nonreimbursable fee for**  
25 **candidacy may apply through the department for not more than a**  
26 **one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) scholarship toward**  
27 **national board certification. Fees for renewal of the national board**  
28 **certificate are at the teacher's own expense.**

29 **Sec. 8. (a) A national board certified teacher is entitled to**  
30 **receive a stipend from the fund in addition to the teacher's annual**  
31 **compensation for serving as a mentor to teachers within the**  
32 **teacher's school or school corporation in a mentoring program**  
33 **approved by the department.**

34 (b) The department shall adopt rules under IC4-22-2 under  
35 which a school corporation may establish a mentoring program  
36 involving national board certified teachers. The rules must specify  
37 the conditions for the mentoring program as well as the amount of  
38 the stipend that will be provided to a teacher serving as a mentor.

39 **Sec. 9. (a) After June 30, 2011, a school corporation shall**  
40 **provide a public school teacher who has attained national board**  
41 **certification as of July 1, 2011, or thereafter with an annual**  
42 **national board certification salary supplement of two thousand**  
43 **dollars (\$2,000) for the life of the certificate. The salary**  
44 **supplement shall be added to the teacher's base salary and shall be**  
45 **considered in the calculation for contributions to the Indiana state**  
46 **teachers' retirement fund.**

47 (b) If a national board certified teacher ceases to be employed

1 as a classroom teacher or a teacher mentor, the salary supplement  
2 under this section ends.

3 (c) A school corporation is entitled to reimbursement from the  
4 fund for salary supplements paid by the school corporation under  
5 this section.

6 Sec. 10. The department shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to  
7 carry out this chapter."
