# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 93 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 4. IC 20-28-5-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.75-2008,
- 3 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 3. (a) The department shall designate:
- 5 (1) the grade point average required for each type of license; and
- 6 (2) the types of licenses to which the teachers' minimum salary
- 7 laws apply, including nonrenewable one (1) year limited licenses.
- 8 (b) The department shall determine details of licensing not provided
- 9 in this chapter, including requirements regarding the following:
- 10 (1) The conversion of one (1) type of license into another.
- 11 (2) The accreditation of teacher education schools and
- 12 departments.
- 13 (3) The exchange and renewal of licenses.
- 14 (4) The endorsement of another state's license.
- 15 (5) The acceptance of credentials from teacher education
- 16 institutions of another state.
- 17 (6) The academic and professional preparation for each type of
- 18 license.
- 19 (7) The granting of permission to teach a high school subject area
- 20 related to the subject area for which the teacher holds a license.
- 21 (8) The issuance of licenses on credentials.
- 22 (9) The type of license required for each school position.
- 23 (10) The size requirements for an elementary school requiring a

- 1 licensed principal.
- 2 (11) Any other related matters.
- 3 The department shall establish at least one (1) system for renewing a
- 4 teaching license that does not require a graduate degree.
- 5 (c) This subsection does not apply to an applicant for a substitute
- 6 teacher license. After June 30, ~~2007~~, **2011**, the department may not
- 7 issue an initial teaching license at any grade level to an applicant for an
- 8 initial teaching license unless the applicant shows evidence that the
- 9 applicant:
- 10 (1) has successfully completed training approved by the
- 11 department in:
- 12 (A) cardiopulmonary resuscitation that includes a test
- 13 demonstration on a mannequin;
- 14 (B) removing a foreign body causing an obstruction in an
- 15 airway; ~~and~~
- 16 (C) the Heimlich maneuver; **and**
- 17 **(D) the use of an automated external defibrillator;**
- 18 (2) holds a valid certification in each of the procedures described
- 19 in subdivision (1) issued by:
- 20 (A) the American Red Cross;
- 21 (B) the American Heart Association; or
- 22 (C) a comparable organization or institution approved by the
- 23 advisory board; or
- 24 (3) has physical limitations that make it impracticable for the
- 25 applicant to complete a course or certification described in
- 26 subdivision (1) or (2).
- 27 **The training in this subsection applies to a teacher (as defined in**
- 28 **IC 20-18-2-22).**
- 29 **(d) This subsection does not apply to an applicant for a**
- 30 **substitute teacher license. After June 30, 2012, the department may**
- 31 **not issue a teaching license renewal at any grade level to an**
- 32 **applicant unless the applicant shows evidence that the applicant:**
- 33 **(1) has successfully completed training approved by the**
- 34 **department in:**
- 35 **(A) cardiopulmonary resuscitation that includes a test**
- 36 **demonstration on a mannequin;**
- 37 **(B) removing a foreign body causing an obstruction in an**
- 38 **airway;**
- 39 **(C) the Heimlich maneuver; and**
- 40 **(D) the use of an automated external defibrillator;**
- 41 **(2) holds a valid certification in each of the procedures**
- 42 **described in subdivision (1) issued by:**
- 43 **(A) the American Red Cross;**
- 44 **(B) the American Heart Association; or**
- 45 **(C) a comparable organization or institution approved by**
- 46 **the advisory board; or**
- 47 **(3) has physical limitations that make it impracticable for the**

 2           **subdivision (1) or (2).**

3           ~~(d)~~ (e) The department shall periodically publish bulletins  
 4 regarding:

- 5           (1) the details described in subsection (b);  
 6           (2) information on the types of licenses issued;  
 7           (3) the rules governing the issuance of each type of license; and  
 8           (4) other similar matters."

9           Page 4, after line 23, begin a new paragraph and insert:

10          "SECTION 6. IC 34-30-14-7, AS ADDED BY P.L.166-2007,  
 11 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
 12 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 7. A teacher:

- 13          (1) who meets the requirement of IC 20-28-5-3(c); and  
 14          (2) who:  
 15              (A) performs cardiopulmonary resuscitation on;  
 16              (B) performs the Heimlich maneuver on; ~~or~~  
 17              (C) removes a foreign body that is obstructing an airway of; **or**  
 18              **(D) uses an automated external defibrillator on;**

19          another person, in the course of employment as a teacher;  
 20 is not liable in a civil action for damages resulting from an act or  
 21 omission occurring during the provision of emergency assistance under  
 22 this section, unless the act or omission constitutes gross negligence or  
 23 willful and wanton misconduct."

24          Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
