# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 577 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 education and to make an appropriation.
- 4 Page 4, between lines 33 and 34, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 "SECTION 9. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011] (a) **This SECTION**
- 6 **supplements the appropriation authority granted in any budget**
- 7 **bill.**
- 8 (b) **The following definitions apply throughout this SECTION:**
- 9 (1) **"Augmentation is allowed" means the governor and the**
- 10 **budget agency are authorized to add to an appropriation in a**
- 11 **budget bill from revenues accruing to the fund from which the**
- 12 **appropriation was made.**
- 13 (2) **"Budget bill" mean a bill for an act, or two (2) or more**
- 14 **such bills by which substantially all of the appropriations are**
- 15 **made that are necessary and required to carry on state**
- 16 **government for the budget period, if and when the bill is, or**
- 17 **the bills are, enacted into law.**
- 18 (3) **"Budget period" means the period beginning July 1, 2011,**
- 19 **and ending June 30, 2013.**
- 20 (4) **"Eligible students" means:**
- 21 (A) **pupils from the soldiers' and sailors' children's home;**
- 22 (B) **Purple Heart recipients and children of Purple Heart**
- 23 **recipients;**
- 24 (C) **dependents of a prisoner of war or person missing in**

- 1           **action;**  
 2           **(D) children of deceased or disabled veterans;**  
 3           **(F) children of National Guard members killed on state**  
 4           **active duty; and**  
 5           **(G) spouses of National Guard members killed on state**  
 6           **active duty.**

7           **(5) "State educational institution" has the meaning set forth**  
 8           **in IC 21-7-13-32.**

9           **(c) The general assembly finds that:**

10           **(1) the appropriation for statutory fee remission in the state**  
 11           **fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011,**  
 12           **will be insufficient to cover the costs of tuition and fees that**  
 13           **are waived by law at a state educational institution for eligible**  
 14           **students;**

15           **(2) the proposed budget bill for the biennium beginning July**  
 16           **1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, flat-lines the appropriation**  
 17           **made for statutory fee remission and will be inadequate to**  
 18           **cover the costs of tuition and fees that are waived by law at a**  
 19           **state educational institution for eligible students, and it is**  
 20           **likely that any enacted budget bill for this budget period will**  
 21           **continue the practice of under-funding the costs of waived**  
 22           **tuition and fees; and**

23           **(3) it would be a disservice to the veterans who served this**  
 24           **country and in some cases paid the ultimate sacrifice, to place**  
 25           **any potential impediment in the way of providing an**  
 26           **education to their spouses and dependents.**

27           **(d) Augmentation is allowed for the appropriation in each state**  
 28           **fiscal year for the state student assistance commission for statutory**  
 29           **fee remission to the extent necessary to carry out this SECTION.**

30           **(e) The state student assistance commission, in order to facilitate**  
 31           **the enrollment and instruction of:**

- 32           **(1) pupils from the soldiers' and sailors' children's home;**  
 33           **(2) Purple Heart recipients and children of Purple Heart**  
 34           **recipients;**  
 35           **(3) dependents of a prisoner of war or person missing in**  
 36           **action;**  
 37           **(4) children of deceased or disabled veterans;**  
 38           **(5) children of National Guard members killed on state active**  
 39           **duty; and**  
 40           **(6) spouses of National Guard members killed on state active**  
 41           **duty;**

42           **without charge at state educational institutions shall reimburse**  
 43           **state educational institutions for one hundred percent (100%) of**  
 44           **the tuition and fees that are waived under IC 10-17-7-3, IC 20-14,**  
 45           **or another law.**

46           **(f) This SECTION expires July 1, 2013."**

47           **Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.**
