MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 99, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 37. IC 4-12-1-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 6. **(a)** When requested
4 so to do by the governor, or by the budget director, other agencies of
5 the state shall assist the budget agency in the effective discharge of its
6 duties and functions. Any such agency shall employ its equipment and
7 facilities to assist the budget agency to prepare the data and
8 information for a recommended or final budget report and budget bill.
9 The budget agency shall create and prepare forms required for the
10 administration of this chapter, and forms necessary for machine
11 accounting to permit accumulation of statistical data and information
12 required by the budget agency and the budget committee. Every state
13 agency, except the universities and colleges, shall adopt such forms and
14 reporting procedures as are created and prepared by the budget agency
15 for administration and execution of appropriations made by law, when
16 such forms and procedures have been otherwise approved in the
17 manner required by law.
18 **(b) The budget agency is responsible and accountable for and
19 has authority over all functions performed by the following:**
20 **(1) The department of state revenue.**
21 **(2) The department of local government finance.**
22 **(3) The Indiana finance authority.**
23 **The directors of these agencies, departments, and offices shall**
24 **report to the director and administer their offices and agencies in**

1 compliance with the policies and procedures related to fiscal
2 management that are established by the budget agency and
3 approved by the governor.

4 (c) The budget agency shall establish metrics for measuring
5 state government performance and efficiency.

6 SECTION 38. IC 4-12-1-6.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
7 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
8 1, 2011]: Sec. 6.5. (a) The budget agency shall perform a cost
9 benefit analysis upon each proposed rule and provide to:

10 (1) the governor; and

11 (2) the administrative rules oversight committee established
12 under IC 2-5-18;

13 an assessment of the rule's effect on Indiana business.

14 (b) After June 30, 2011, the cost benefit analysis performed by
15 the budget agency under this section with respect to any proposed
16 rule that has an impact of at least five hundred thousand dollars
17 (\$500,000) shall replace and be used for all purposes under
18 IC 4-22-2 in lieu of the fiscal analysis previously performed by the
19 legislative services agency under IC 4-22-2.

20 SECTION 38. IC 4-12-1-6.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
21 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
22 1, 2011]: Sec. 6.6. (a) As used in this section, "coordinator" means
23 the following:

24 (1) A small business regulatory coordinator (as defined in
25 IC 4-22-2-28.1(b)).

26 (2) An ombudsman designated under IC 13-28-3-2.

27 (3) An ombudsman designated under IC 5-28-17-5.

28 (b) Each coordinator may review proposed legislation affecting
29 the small businesses that are regulated by the budget agency or
30 that would be regulated by the budget agency under proposed
31 legislation. A coordinator may submit to the budget agency written
32 comments concerning the impact of proposed legislation on small
33 business.

34 (c) The budget agency may review comments received under
35 subsection (b). The budget agency may amend the comments. After
36 completing its review, the budget agency shall transmit the
37 comments to the legislative services agency for posting on the
38 general assembly's web site. The comments submitted under this
39 section shall be transmitted electronically in a format suitable for
40 posting to the general assembly's web site as determined by the
41 legislative services agency. "

42 Page 135, line 38, after "2012]:" insert "IC 4-3-22;".

43 Page 139, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new paragraph and
44 insert:

45 "SECTION 96. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in
46 this SECTION, "agency" refers to the budget agency created by
47 IC 4-12-1-3.

- 1 **(b) As used in this SECTION, "office" refers to the office of**
- 2 **management and budget created by IC 4-3-22-3 before its repeal**
- 3 **by this act.**
- 4 **(c) After June 30, 2011, the following apply:**
- 5 **(1) The powers and duties of the office are transferred to the**
- 6 **agency.**
- 7 **(2) A reference to the office in a statute, a rule, or another**
- 8 **document shall be treated as a reference to the agency.**
- 9 **(3) A reference to the office in a statute, a rule, or another**
- 10 **document shall be treated as a reference to the agency.**
- 11 **(4) All the property of the office is transferred to the agency.**
- 12 **(5) An appropriation to the office in effect after June 30, 2011,**
- 13 **is transferred to the agency.**
- 14 **(6) All leases and obligations entered into by the office before**
- 15 **July 1, 2011, that are legal and valid on July 1, 2011, are**
- 16 **obligations of the agency beginning July 1, 2011.**
- 17 **(d) This SECTION expires July 1, 2012.**
- 18 SECTION 97. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) As used in this**
- 19 **SECTION, "agency" refers to the budget agency created by**
- 20 **IC 4-12-1-3.**
- 21 **(b) The legislative services agency shall prepare legislation for**
- 22 **introduction in the 2012 regular session of the general assembly to**
- 23 **organize and correct statutes affected by this act.**
- 24 **(c) This SECTION expires July 1, 2012."**
- 25 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
