MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 120, between lines 43 and 44, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 "SECTION 65. IC 20-40-8-11, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2006,
- 4 SECTION 163, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 11. Money in the fund may be used
- 6 to pay for the purchase, lease, repair, or maintenance of equipment to
- 7 be used by the school corporation. However, money in the fund may
- 8 not be used to pay for the purchase, lease, repair, or maintenance of the
- 9 following:
- 10 (1) Vehicles ~~to be used for any purpose.~~ **other than maintenance**
- 11 **vehicles.**
- 12 (2) Except as provided in section 12 of this chapter, equipment to
- 13 be used primarily for interscholastic or extracurricular activities.
- 14 SECTION 66. IC 20-40-8-16, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2006,
- 15 SECTION 163, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 16 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 16. (a) For purposes of this section,
- 17 maintenance does not include janitorial or comparable routine services
- 18 normally provided in the daily operation of the facilities or equipment.
- 19 (b) Subject to this section, money in the fund may be used to pay for
- 20 services of school corporation employees who are:
- 21 (1) bricklayers;
- 22 (2) stone masons;
- 23 (3) cement masons;
- 24 (4) tile setters;

- 1 (5) glaziers;
 2 (6) insulation workers;
 3 (7) asbestos removers;
 4 (8) painters;
 5 (9) paperhangers;
 6 (10) drywall applicators and tapers;
 7 (11) plasterers;
 8 (12) pipe fitters;
 9 (13) roofers;
 10 (14) structural and steel workers;
 11 (15) metal building assemblers;
 12 (16) heating and air conditioning installers;
 13 (17) welders;
 14 (18) carpenters;
 15 (19) electricians; or
 16 (20) plumbers;
- 17 as these occupations are defined in the United States Department of
 18 Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Dictionary of
 19 Occupational Titles, Fourth Edition, Revised 1991.
- 20 (c) Payment may be made under this section for employee services
 21 described in subsection (b) only if:
- 22 (1) the employees perform:
 23 (A) construction of;
 24 (B) renovation of;
 25 (C) remodeling of;
 26 (D) repair of; or
 27 (E) maintenance on;
 28 the facilities and equipment specified in sections 10 and 11 of this
 29 chapter; **and**
 30 ~~(2) the total of all annual salaries and benefits paid by the school~~
 31 ~~corporation to employees described in this section is at least six~~
 32 ~~hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000); and~~
 33 ~~(3) (2) the payment of the employees described in this section is~~
 34 ~~included as part of the school corporation's proposed plan.~~
- 35 ~~(d) The number of employees covered by this section is limited to~~
 36 ~~the number of employee positions described in this section that existed~~

- 38 SECTION 67. IC 20-40-8-19, AS AMENDED BY
 39 P.L.182-2009(ss), SECTION 322, IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 40 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 19. Money in the fund
 41 may be used **before January 1, 2014**, to pay for up to one hundred
 42 percent (100%) of the following costs of a school corporation:
 43 (1) Utility services.
 44 (2) Property or casualty insurance.
 45 (3) Both utility services and property or casualty insurance.
 46 A school corporation's expenditures under this section may not **in a**

1 **calendar year** exceed ~~in 2010~~ ~~and in 2011~~ three and five-tenths
2 percent (3.5%) of the school corporation's 2005 calendar year
3 distribution.
4 SECTION 68. IC 20-40-8-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
5 CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS**
6 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: **Sec. 22. Money in the fund may be**
7 **used to pay for up to one hundred percent (100%) of the costs**
8 **incurred by a school corporation under a service contract for the**
9 **maintenance and care of real property owned by the school**
10 **corporation."**
11 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
