# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 13, delete line 37, begin a new line block indented and insert:
- 2 **"Total Operating Expense 2,000,000 2,000,000".**
- 3 Page 13, line 39, delete "appropriation" and insert
- 4 **"appropriations".**
- 5 Page 98, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 36. IC 4-7-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
- 7 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 8 1, 2011]:
- 9 **Chapter 5. Indiana Transparency Portal**
- 10 **Sec. 1. (a) As used in this chapter, "state agency" means an**
- 11 **authority, a board, a branch, a commission, a committee, a**
- 12 **department, a division, or another instrumentality of government,**
- 13 **including the administrative branch of state government, the**
- 14 **legislative branch of state government, and the judicial branch of**
- 15 **state government.**
- 16 **(b) The term does not include a state educational institution.**
- 17 **Sec. 2. The auditor of state shall:**
- 18 **(1) maintain a comprehensive data base of nonconfidential**
- 19 **information pertaining to the state's finances; and**
- 20 **(2) make the data base specified in subdivision (1) publicly**
- 21 **available on the auditor of state's Internet web site.**
- 22 **The information system described in this section is known as the**
- 23 **Indiana transparency portal.**
- 24 **Sec. 3. The Indiana transparency portal must include**

1 mechanisms that readily allow a user of the system to search for,  
2 display, and retrieve information maintained in the system.

3 **Sec. 4. The information maintained in the Indiana transparency**  
4 **portal must include the following:**

- 5 (1) **Budget information.**
- 6 (2) **State revenues.**
- 7 (3) **State expenditures, including expenditures for:**
  - 8 (A) **the compensation of state employees; and**
  - 9 (B) **state contracts.**
- 10 (4) **Fund balances.**

11 **Sec. 5. (a) The auditor of state may request that a state agency**  
12 **furnish information held by the state agency to the auditor of state**  
13 **for inclusion in the Indiana transparency portal.**

14 (b) **Except as provided in subsection (c), a state agency that has**  
15 **received a request for information from the auditor of state shall**  
16 **cooperate in furnishing the requested information to the auditor of**  
17 **state.**

18 (c) **A state agency shall refuse a request for information from**  
19 **the auditor of state under subsection (a) to the extent that the**  
20 **requested information is confidential under state or federal law.**

21 **Sec. 6. If a state agency is required to submit information to the**  
22 **auditor of state for inclusion in the Indiana transparency portal**  
23 **under section 5 of this chapter or any other law, the state agency**  
24 **shall submit the information in an electronic format specified by**  
25 **the auditor of state.**

26 **Sec. 7. At the conclusion of each state fiscal year, the budget**  
27 **agency shall submit to the auditor of state for inclusion in the**  
28 **Indiana transparency portal a detailed explanation of the**  
29 **expenditures from the departmental and institutional emergency**  
30 **and contingency fund during the state fiscal year."**

31 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
