MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 59, delete line 2, begin a new line and insert:
- 2 "35,829,584 35,829,584".
- 3 Page 59, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new line and insert:
- 4 "Community Services 13,736,809 13,736,809".
- 5 Page 59, between lines 12 and 13, begin a new line and insert:
- 6 "The foregoing amounts designated for community services are for
- 7 the purpose of providing services in a community setting to an
- 8 individual who is a patient at the Logansport State Hospital at any
- 9 time during the biennium and is relocated as part of an initiative
- 10 to close or reduce services at the Logansport State Hospital, up to
- 11 and including the cost the Logansport State Hospital would have
- 12 incurred if the patient had not been relocated and had remained in
- 13 the Logansport State Hospital."
- 14 Page 59, delete line 28, begin a new line and insert:
- 15 "35,485,115 35,485,115".
- 16 Page 59, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new line and insert:
- 17 "Community Services 4,928,549 4,928,549".
- 18 Page 59, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new line and insert:
- 19 "The foregoing amounts designated for community services are for
- 20 the purpose of providing services in a community setting to an
- 21 individual who is a patient at the Richmond State Hospital at any
- 22 time during the biennium and is relocated as part of an initiative
- 23 to close or reduce services at the Richmond State Hospital, up to
- 24 and including the cost the Richmond State Hospital would have

1 **incurred if the patient had not been relocated and had remained in**  
 2 **the Richmond State Hospital."**

3 Page 98, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
 4 "SECTION 36. IC 4-7-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
 5 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
 6 1, 2011]:

7 **Chapter 5. Indiana Transparency Portal**

8 **Sec. 1. (a) As used in this chapter, "state agency" means an**  
 9 **authority, a board, a branch, a commission, a committee, a**  
 10 **department, a division, or another instrumentality of government,**  
 11 **including the administrative branch of state government, the**  
 12 **legislative branch of state government, and the judicial branch of**  
 13 **state government.**

14 **(b) The term does not include a state educational institution.**

15 **Sec. 2. The auditor of state shall:**

16 **(1) maintain a comprehensive data base of nonconfidential**  
 17 **information pertaining to the state's finances; and**

18 **(2) make the data base specified in subdivision (1) publicly**  
 19 **available on the auditor of state's Internet web site.**

20 **The information system described in this section is known as the**  
 21 **Indiana transparency portal.**

22 **Sec. 3. The Indiana transparency portal must include**  
 23 **mechanisms that readily allow a user of the system to search for,**  
 24 **display, and retrieve information maintained in the system.**

25 **Sec. 4. The information maintained in the Indiana transparency**  
 26 **portal must include the following:**

27 **(1) Budget information.**

28 **(2) State revenues.**

29 **(3) State expenditures, including expenditures for:**

30 **(A) the compensation of state employees; and**

31 **(B) state contracts.**

32 **(4) Fund balances.**

33 **Sec. 5. (a) The auditor of state may request that a state agency**  
 34 **furnish information held by the state agency to the auditor of state**  
 35 **for inclusion in the Indiana transparency portal.**

36 **(b) Except as provided in subsection (c), a state agency that has**  
 37 **received a request for information from the auditor of state shall**  
 38 **cooperate in furnishing the requested information to the auditor of**  
 39 **state.**

40 **(c) A state agency shall refuse a request for information from**  
 41 **the auditor of state under subsection (a) to the extent that the**  
 42 **requested information is confidential under state or federal law.**

43 **Sec. 6. If a state agency is required to submit information to the**  
 44 **auditor of state for inclusion in the Indiana transparency portal**  
 45 **under section 5 of this chapter or any other law, the state agency**  
 46 **shall submit the information in an electronic format specified by**  
 47 **the auditor of state.**

1           **Sec. 7. (a) As used in this section, "affected state hospital" refers**  
2 **to the following:**

3           **(1) Richmond State Hospital.**

4           **(2) Logansport State Hospital.**

5           **(b) Before October 1, 2012, for the state fiscal year ending June**  
6 **30, 2012, and before October 1, 2013, for the state fiscal year**  
7 **ending June 30, 2013, the office of the secretary of family and**  
8 **social services shall submit a report to the auditor of state for**  
9 **inclusion in the Indiana transparency portal that explains the**  
10 **extent and manner in which the budget appropriations to provide**  
11 **services in a community setting to patients of an affected state**  
12 **hospital that were relocated as part of the initiative to close or**  
13 **reduce services offered by the affected state hospital have been**  
14 **expended."**

15           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
