# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 99, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 37. IC 4-12-1-19 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 4 1, 2011]; **Sec. 19. (a) The following definitions apply throughout**
- 5 **this section:**
- 6 (1) "Budget bill" refers to a budget bill (as defined in
- 7 IC 4-12-1-2) that is enacted in an odd-numbered year.
- 8 (2) "State general fund appropriations" refers to the sum of
- 9 the specific amounts appropriated by a budget bill from the
- 10 state general fund for expenditure in a particular state fiscal
- 11 year. The term includes any amount appropriated in a budget
- 12 bill for a period exceeding one (1) state fiscal year that is
- 13 allocated by the budget agency to a particular state fiscal year
- 14 in a list of appropriations prepared under IC 4-12-1-12.
- 15 (3) "General revenue fund" refers to the following:
- 16 (A) Counter-cyclical revenue and economic stabilization
- 17 fund (IC 4-10-18-2).
- 18 (B) State general fund, including the Medicaid contingency
- 19 and reserve account of the state general fund
- 20 (IC 4-12-1-15.5).
- 21 (C) State tuition reserve fund (IC 4-12-1-15.7).
- 22 (D) The public deposits insurance fund (IC 5-13-12).
- 23 (4) "State fiscal year" means a period beginning July 1 in one
- 24 (1) calendar year and ending on June 30 in the immediately

1           succeeding calendar year.

2           **(b) The state budget agency shall include the balances in all**  
3 **funds listed as a general revenue fund as part of any publication of**  
4 **a combined statement of general fund actual and estimated**  
5 **unappropriated reserve.**

6           **(c) If in administering the state general fund appropriations**  
7 **made in a budget bill, the governor determines that money needs**  
8 **to be transferred from the public deposits insurance fund to**  
9 **support the state general fund appropriations, the governor may**  
10 **request that the board for depositories transfer an amount to the**  
11 **general fund by providing a written notice to each member of the**  
12 **legislative council and each member of the budget committee that**  
13 **sets forth the amount of the requested transfer. The notice must be**  
14 **provided ten (10) days before the request is made to the board for**  
15 **depositories.**

16           **(d) The board for depositories is granted the authority to make**  
17 **a transfer from the public deposits insurance fund if it is requested**  
18 **by the governor. The transfer shall be made to the treasurer of**  
19 **state before the end of the state fiscal year during which the**  
20 **transfer is requested."**

21           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
