MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1002 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 12, between lines 29 and 30, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 5. IC 20-20-1-0.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: **Sec. 0.3. As used in this chapter,**
5 **"accredited educational service center" means an educational**
6 **service center that on January 1, 2011:**
7 **(1) was accredited by:**
8 **(A) the National Collegiate Athletic Association to provide**
9 **secondary school courses that meet the academic eligibility**
10 **requirements for participation in an athletic program of a**
11 **member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association;**
12 **and**
13 **(B) the North Central Association of Colleges;**
14 **(2) had a program to provide approved online courses; and**
15 **(3) offered:**
16 **(A) advanced placement courses approved by the College**
17 **Board;**
18 **(B) the complete Core 40 curriculum; and**
19 **(C) the Indiana state standards aligned curriculum for**
20 **grades 9 through 12; and**
21 **continues to maintain the accreditation described in subdivision (1)**
22 **after January 1, 2011.**
23 SECTION 6. IC 20-20-1-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
24 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY

1, 2011]: **Sec. 0.5.** As used in this chapter, "approved online course" refers to a course of study that:

- 3 (1) is approved by the department for credit toward
- 4 graduation from high school;
- 5 (2) complies with the approved course description; and
- 6 (3) is delivered through:
 - 7 (A) virtual distance learning;
 - 8 (B) online technologies; or
 - 9 (C) computer based instruction;

10 **under the supervision of a teacher licensed in Indiana.**

11 SECTION 7. IC 20-20-1-1.4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 12 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 13 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 1.4.** As used in this chapter, "credit" has
 14 **the meaning set forth in 511 IAC 6-7.1-1.**

15 SECTION 8. IC 20-20-1-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 16 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 17 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 13.** (a) This section applies to credits
 18 earned from an accredited educational service center for an
 19 approved online course.

20 (b) A school corporation or charter school shall accept credits
 21 earned by students in approved online courses in a uniform and
 22 consistent manner, according to the same criteria that are used to
 23 accept academic credits from other public schools.

24 SECTION 9. IC 20-20-1-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 25 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 26 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 14.** (a) The department shall establish a
 27 pilot program to provide funding to an accredited educational
 28 service center for a total of not more than:

- 29 (1) two thousand (2,000) credits awarded to students who
- 30 complete an approved online course of study in a school year
- 31 beginning after June 30, 2011, and ending before July 1, 2012;
- 32 and
- 33 (2) two thousand (2,000) credits awarded to students who
- 34 complete an approved online course of study in a school year
- 35 beginning after June 30, 2012, and ending before July 1, 2013.

36 (b) To qualify for funding under this section, an accredited
 37 educational service center must enter into a written agreement
 38 with the department setting out the terms and conditions under
 39 which the accredited educational service center will award credit
 40 for specified approved online courses successfully completed by the
 41 student through the accredited educational service center.

42 (c) The department shall not later than January 15, 2012, and
 43 January 15, 2013, submit an annual report to the budget committee
 44 concerning the impact of the program under this section to do one
 45 (1) or more of the following:

- 46 (1) Increase student graduation on time.
- 47 (2) Provide cost savings to public schools and the state for

- 1 credit recovery.
- 2 (3) Improve student access to classes that public schools are
- 3 unable to provide in subjects such as the higher levels of
- 4 calculus, physics, chemistry and other math and sciences
- 5 classes.
- 6 (4) Provide access to American Sign Language and other
- 7 foreign languages that public schools are unable to provide
- 8 due to cost or lack of teacher resources.
- 9 (5) Provide access to classes when public schools are unable to
- 10 offer the classes due to a lack of sufficient enrollment to
- 11 justify the hiring of a teacher.
- 12 (6) Increase completion of high school graduation
- 13 requirements by students who are not otherwise able to
- 14 complete all high school requirements for financial,
- 15 behavioral, homebound, or other reasons.
- 16 (7) Provide cost savings to the state and public schools for
- 17 home bound instruction.
- 18 (8) Expand educational opportunities to all students
- 19 regardless of urban, rural, or financial capabilities.
- 20 (d) The department shall reimburse an accredited educational
- 21 service center at the rate of three hundred dollars (\$300) per credit
- 22 granted for successful completion of an approved online course.
- 23 The amount distributed to an accredited educational service center
- 24 under this section shall be paid from the amount appropriated for
- 25 state tuition support for a state fiscal year beginning after June 30,
- 26 2011, and ending before July 1, 2013.
- 27 (e) The department may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to govern
- 28 the implementation of this section.
- 29 (f) This section expires January 1, 2014."
- 30 Page 13, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new line block indented
- 31 and insert:
- 32 "(6) An accredited educational service center (as defined in
- 33 IC 20-20-1-0.3)."
- 34 Page 22, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 35 "(f) This subsection applies to a sponsor that is an accredited
- 36 educational service center (as defined in IC 20-20-1-0.3) that is
- 37 approved by the state board. In a calendar year, an accredited
- 38 educational service center may collect from the organizer of a
- 39 charter school an administrative fee equal to not more than three
- 40 percent (3%) of the total amount the organizer receives during the
- 41 calendar year for basic tuition support."
- 42 Page 22, line 15, delete "(f)" and insert "(g)".
- 43 Page 22, line 20, delete "(g)" and insert "(h)".
- 44 Page 22, line 24, delete "(h)" and insert "(i)".
- 45 Page 22, line 31, delete "(i)" and insert "(j)".
- 46 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
