MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1002 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 32, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 35. IC 20-31-9-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005,
- 3 SECTION 15, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 2. (a) This section applies the first year that a
- 5 school is placed in the lowest category or designation of school
- 6 improvement.
- 7 (b) The state board shall place the school, ~~and~~ the school
- 8 corporation, **and the charter sponsor, if the school corporation is a**
- 9 **charter school**, on notice that the school is in the lowest category or
- 10 designation of school improvement. Upon receiving the notice, the
- 11 governing body shall:
- 12 (1) issue a public notice of the school's lack of improvement; and
- 13 (2) hold a public hearing in which public testimony is received
- 14 concerning the lack of improvement.
- 15 (c) The committee shall revise the school's plan. A revision under
- 16 this subsection may include any of the following:
- 17 (1) Shifting resources.
- 18 (2) Changing personnel.
- 19 (3) Requesting the state board to appoint an outside team to
- 20 manage the school or assist in the development of a new plan.
- 21 (d) If the governing body approves a request for the state board to
- 22 appoint an outside team under subsection (c)(3), the school is
- 23 considered to be placed under section 3 of this chapter.
- 24 SECTION 36. IC 20-31-9-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005,

1 SECTION 15, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
2 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 3. (a) This section applies if, in the third year after
3 initial placement in the lowest category or designation, a school still
4 remains in the lowest category or designation.

5 **(b) This subsection applies to a school corporation that is not a**
6 **charter school.** The state board shall establish and assign an expert
7 team to the school. The expert team:

8 (1) must include representatives from the community or region
9 that the school serves; and

10 (2) may include:

11 (A) school superintendents, members of governing bodies, and
12 teachers from school corporations that are in high categories
13 or designations; and

14 (B) special consultants or advisers.

15 **(c) If the school corporation is a charter school, the sponsor or**
16 **authorizing body shall establish and assign an expert team to the**
17 **school. The expert team:**

18 **(1) must include representatives from the community or**
19 **region that the school serves; and**

20 **(2) may include:**

21 **(A) a member of the state charter board established under**
22 **IC 20-24-2.1, members of governing bodies and teachers**
23 **from school corporations that are in high categories or**
24 **designations, and parents of students attending the school;**
25 **and**

26 **(B) special consultants or advisers.**

27 ~~(c)~~ **(d)** The expert team shall:

28 (1) assist the school in revising the school's plan; and

29 (2) recommend changes in the school that will promote
30 improvement, including the reallocation of resources or requests
31 for technical assistance.

33 SECTION 15, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
34 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 4. (a) This section applies if, in the fifth year after
35 initial placement in the lowest category or designation, a school still
36 remains in the lowest category or designation.

37 **(b) This subsection applies to a school corporation that is not a**
38 **charter school.** The state board shall do the following:

39 (1) Hold at least one (1) public hearing in the school corporation
40 where the school is located to consider and hear testimony
41 concerning the following options for school improvement:

42 (A) Merging the school with a nearby school that is in a higher
43 category.

44 (B) Assigning a special management team to operate all or
45 part of the school.

46 (C) The department's recommendations for improving the

- 2 (D) Other options for school improvement expressed at the

- 13 **(1) Hold at least one (1) public hearing in the school**
- 14 **community where the school is located to consider and hear**
- 15 **testimony concerning the following options for school**
- 16 **improvement:**
- 17 **(A) Merging the school with a nearby school or charter**
- 18 **school that is in a higher category.**
- 19 **(B) Assigning a special management team to operate all or**
- 20 **part of the school.**
- 21 **(C) The department's recommendations for improving the**
- 22 **school.**
- 23 **(D) Other options for school improvement expressed at the**
- 24 **public hearing, including closing the school and revoking**
- 25 **the charter.**
- 26 **(E) Revising the school's plan in any of the following areas:**
- 27 **(i) Changes in school procedures or operations.**
- 28 **(ii) Professional development.**
- 29 **(iii) Intervention for individual teachers or**
- 30 **administrators.**
- 31 **(2) If the state board determines that intervention will**
- 32 **improve the school, implement at least one (1) of the options**
- 33 **listed in subdivision (1)."**
