HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1121 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, between lines 9 and 10, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 “SECTION 1. IC 25-22.5-6-2.2 IS ADDED TO THE
- 4 INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS
- 5 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: **Sec. 2.2. (a) Except**
- 6 **as provided in subsection (c), before a physician performs**
- 7 **a hysterectomy or an oophorectomy, the physician shall**
- 8 **obtain oral and written informed consent from the patient.**
- 9 **The informed consent procedure must ensure that the**
- 10 **following information is given to the patient at least two (2)**
- 11 **weeks before the patient signs the consent form:**
- 12 (1) **Advice that the individual is free to withhold or**
- 13 **withdraw consent to the procedure at any time before**
- 14 **the hysterectomy or oophorectomy without affecting**
- 15 **the right to future care or treatment and without loss**
- 16 **or withdrawal of any state or federally funded**
- 17 **program benefits to which the individual might be**
- 18 **otherwise entitled.**
- 19 (2) **A copy of the DVD entitled "Female Anatomy: The**
- 20 **Functions of the Female Organs" produced by the**
- 21 **HERS Foundation, including a printed transcript of**
- 22 **the text of the DVD.**

- 1 **(3) A copy of the pamphlet entitled "Hysterectomy**
2 **Pamphlet - True or False" produced by the HERS**
3 **Foundation.**
- 4 **(4) A color copy of the following diagrams:**
- 5 **(A) The female pelvic organs.**
6 **(B) Supporting structures of the female pelvic**
7 **organs.**
8 **(C) Nerve supply to the uterus and ovaries.**
9 **(D) Arteries and veins that provide blood supply**
10 **to the female pelvic organs.**
- 11 **(b) The patient shall sign a written statement before the**
12 **hysterectomy or oophorectomy is performed, indicating she**
13 **has read and understood the written information provided**
14 **under subsection (a), and that this information has been**
15 **discussed with her by her attending physician and surgeon,**
16 **or the physician's and surgeon's designee. The statement**
17 **must indicate that the patient has been advised by the**
18 **patient's physician or the physician's designee that the**
19 **hysterectomy or oophorectomy will render the patient**
20 **permanently sterile and incapable of having children.**
- 21 **(c) The informed consent procedure under this section**
22 **is not required when the hysterectomy or oophorectomy is**
23 **performed in a life threatening emergency situation in**
24 **which the physician determines prior written informed**
25 **consent is not possible.**
- 26 **(d) If, after a hearing, the board finds that a physician**
27 **has not complied with this section, the physician is subject**
28 **to disciplinary sanctions under IC 25-1-9.”.**
- 29 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
