Citations Affected: IC 5-14; IC 34-30.

Synopsis: Access to state financial data. Requires the auditor of state, the commission for higher education, the department of education, and the department of local government finance to work with the office of technology and other agencies to post on the Indiana transparency Internet web site a data base of: (1) state expenditures and fund balances; (2) property owned by the state; and (3) expenditures and fund balances for educational institutions, local governments, and local schools.

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 2011.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1004

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-14-3.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]:

4 **Chapter 3.5. Access to Financial Data for State Agencies**

5 **Sec. 1. (a) As used in this chapter, "state agency" means an**
6 **authority, a board, a branch, a commission, a committee, a**
7 **department, a division, or another instrumentality of government,**
8 **including the administrative branch of state government, the**
9 **legislative branch of state government, and the judicial branch of**
10 **state government.**

11 **(b) The term does not include a state educational institution.**

12 **Sec. 2. (a) The auditor of state, working with the office of**
13 **technology established by IC 4-13.1-2-1, or another organization**
14 **that is part of a state educational institution, and the office of**
15 **management and budget established by IC 4-3-22-3, shall post on**
16 **the Indiana transparency Internet web site the following data:**

17 **(1) A listing of state expenditures and fund balances, including**

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1 expenditures for contracts, grants, and leases.
 2 (2) A listing of state owned real and personal property.
 3 The web site must be electronically searchable by the public.
 4 (b) The data base must include for each state agency:
 5 (1) the amount, date, payer, and payee of expenditures;
 6 (2) a listing of state expenditures by:
 7 (A) personal services;
 8 (B) other operating expenses; or
 9 (C) total operating expenses;
 10 to reflect how the funds were appropriated in the state budget
 11 act;
 12 (3) a listing of state fund balances; and
 13 (4) a listing of property owned by the state.
 14 Sec. 3. To the extent possible, the auditor of state shall present
 15 information in the data base established under this chapter in a
 16 manner that is searchable and intuitive to users. The auditor of
 17 state shall enhance and organize the presentation of the
 18 information through the use of graphic representations, including
 19 pie charts, if the auditor of state considers graphics appropriate.
 20 Sec. 4. (a) The auditor of state may not allow public access
 21 under this section to:
 22 (1) a payee's address;
 23 (2) personal information that is protected under state or
 24 federal law or rule; or
 25 (3) information that is protected as a trade secret under state
 26 or federal law or by rule.
 27 (b) The auditor of state may make information protected under
 28 subsection (a) available in an aggregate format only.
 29 Sec. 5. The auditor of state and employees of the auditor of state
 30 are immune from any civil liability for posting confidential
 31 information under section 4 of this chapter if the auditor of state
 32 or an employee of the auditor of state posted the information in
 33 reliance on a determination made by a state agency about the
 34 confidentiality of information relating to the agency's expenditures
 35 or fund balances.
 36 Sec. 6. To the extent any information required to be in the data
 37 base is collected or maintained by a state agency, the state agency
 38 shall provide that information to the auditor of state for inclusion
 39 in the data base.
 40 Sec. 7. The auditor of state may not charge a fee for access to
 41 the data base.
 42 Sec. 8. Except as provided in section 9 of this chapter, a state

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1 agency shall cooperate with and provide information to the auditor
2 of state as necessary to implement and administer this chapter.

3 Sec. 9. This chapter does not require a state agency to record
4 information or expend resources for the purpose of computer
5 programming to make information reportable under this chapter.

6 Sec. 10. The office of technology established by IC 4-13.1-2-1
7 shall work with the auditor of state to include a link on the Internet
8 web site established under this chapter to the Internet web site of
9 each Internet web site operated by:

- 10 (1) the state; or
- 11 (2) a state agency.

12 Sec. 11. Each state agency shall include a link on the agency's
13 Internet web site to the Internet web site established under this
14 chapter.

15 Sec. 12. The auditor of state and the office of technology shall
16 initially complete the design of the Internet web site and establish
17 and post the information required under this chapter for all state
18 agencies.

19 Sec. 13. Not later than November 15, 2011, the auditor of state
20 shall provide a report to the state board of finance and the
21 legislative council that details the progress the auditor has made to
22 comply with this chapter. The report to the legislative council must
23 be in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.

25 require that forms required to be submitted under this chapter be

36 has the meaning set forth in IC 21-7-13-32.

37 Sec. 3. (a) The commission, working with the office of
38 technology established by IC 4-13.1-2-1 or another organization
39 that is part of a state educational institution, the state board of
40 accounts established by IC 5-11-1-1, and the office of management
41 and budget established by IC 4-3-22-3, shall post on the Indiana
42 transparency Internet web site a data base that lists state

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1 expenditures and fund balances, including expenditures for
2 contracts, grants, and leases for state educational institutions. The
3 web site must be electronically searchable by the public.

4 (b) The listings must include for each state educational
5 institution:

6 (1) the amount, date, payer, and payee of expenditures;

7 (2) a listing of state expenditures by:

8 (A) personal services;

9 (B) other operating expenses; or

10 (C) total operating expenses;

11 to reflect how the funds were appropriated in the state budget
12 act;

13 (3) a listing of state fund balances; and

14 (4) a listing of real and personal property owned by the
15 educational institution.

16 Sec. 4. To the extent possible, the commission shall present
17 information in the data base established under this chapter in a
18 manner that is searchable and intuitive to users.

37 the office for inclusion in the data base.

40 Sec. 9. Except as provided in section 10 of this chapter, a state
41 educational institution shall cooperate with and provide
42 information to the office as necessary to implement and administer

36 management and budget established by IC 4-3-22-3, shall post on
