HOUSE BILL No. 1285

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011] (a) As used in this
2 SECTION, "commission" refers to the commission on state tax and
3 financing policy established in IC 2-5-3-2.

4 (b) The commission shall:

5 (1) study the question of whether the property tax exemption
6 provided under IC 6-1.1-10-16(a) for a building owned,
7 operated, and used by a person for educational, literary,
8 scientific, religious, or charitable purposes should be extended
9 in some way; and

10 (2) report the commission's findings and recommendations on
11 the question described in subdivision (1) before November 1,
12 2011, in the manner required by the legislative council for
13 reports by interim study committees, together with the
14 commission's findings and recommendations on any other
15 topics assigned to the commission for reporting before
16 November 1, 2011.

17 (c) This SECTION expires December 31, 2011.
