*Your Committee on Family, Children and Human Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill 4, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 12-21-5-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.99-2007,
- 4 SECTION 103, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 2. The division is responsible for
- 6 the following:
- 7 (1) The planning, research, and development of programs and
- 8 methods for the education and treatment of children with an
- 9 emotional disturbance.
- 10 (2) The coordination of governmental services, activities, and
- 11 programs in Indiana relating to such children.
- 12 (3) The administration of the state supported services concerned
- 13 with such children.

1 (4) The preparation of the annual report required by IC 7.1-6-2-5.

2 **(5) The provision of information and guidance to local school**
 3 **corporations on the development of evidence based programs**
 4 **for basic or inservice courses for teachers and training for**
 5 **teachers on the following:**

6 (A) **Prevention of child suicide.**

7 (B) **Recognition of signs that a student may be considering**

 12 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 3. (a) The department shall designate:

- 13 (1) the grade point average required for each type of license; and
 14 (2) the types of licenses to which the teachers' minimum salary
 15 laws apply, including nonrenewable one (1) year limited licenses.

16 (b) The department shall determine details of licensing not provided
 17 in this chapter, including requirements regarding the following:

- 18 (1) The conversion of one (1) type of license into another.
 19 (2) The accreditation of teacher education schools and
 20 departments.
 21 (3) The exchange and renewal of licenses.
 22 (4) The endorsement of another state's license.
 23 (5) The acceptance of credentials from teacher education
 24 institutions of another state.

 16 applicant to complete a course or certification described in

- 18 **(d) This subsection does not apply to an applicant for a**
 19 **substitute teacher license. After June 30, 2013, the department may**

 23 **and training on the prevention of child suicide and the recognition**
 24 **of signs that a student may be considering suicide.**
