MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Public Health, to which was referred House Bill 1020, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 12-21-6.5-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.12-2006,
- 4 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to
- 6 the Indiana commission on mental health **and addictions** established
- 7 by section 2 of this chapter.
- 8 SECTION 2. IC 12-21-6.5-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.12-2006,
- 9 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 10 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 2. The Indiana commission on mental health **and**
- 11 **addictions** is established.
- 12 SECTION 3. IC 12-21-6.5-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.12-2006,
- 13 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 14 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 3. The commission consists of seventeen (17)

1 members determined as follows:

2 (1) The speaker of the house of representatives and the president
3 pro tempore of the senate shall each appoint two (2) legislative
4 members, who may not be from the same political party, to serve
5 on the commission.

6 (2) The governor shall appoint thirteen (13) lay members, not
7 more than seven (7) of whom may be from the same political
8 party, to serve on the commission for a term of four (4) years as
9 follows:

10 (A) Four (4) at-large members, not more than two (2) of whom
11 may be from the same political party.

12 (B) Two (2) consumers of mental health **or addictions**
13 services.

14 (C) Two (2) representatives of different advocacy groups for
15 consumers of mental health **or addictions** services.

16 (D) Two (2) members of families of consumers of mental
17 health services.

18 (E) Three (3) members who represent mental health providers.
19 One (1) of the members appointed under this clause must be
20 a representative of a for-profit psychiatric provider. One (1) of
21 the members appointed under this clause must be a physician
22 licensed under IC 25-22.5.

23 (3) The governor shall ensure that the members appointed under
24 subdivision (2) represent all geographic areas of Indiana.

25 SECTION 4. IC 12-21-6.5-8, AS ADDED BY P.L.12-2006,
26 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
27 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 8. The commission shall do the following:

28 (1) Study and evaluate the funding system for mental health **and**
29 **addictions** services in Indiana.

30 (2) Review and make specific recommendations regarding the
31 provision of mental health **and addictions** services delivered by
32 community providers and state operated hospitals. The review and
33 recommendations must cover services to all age groups including
34 children, youth, and adults.

35 (3) Review and make recommendations regarding any unmet need
36 for public supported mental health **and addictions** services:

37 (A) in any specific geographic area; or

38 (B) throughout Indiana.

1 In formulating recommendations, the commission shall consider
2 the need, feasibility, and desirability of including additional
3 organizations in the network of providers of mental health **and**
4 **addictions** services.
5 (4) Monitor the implementation of managed care for ~~the mentally~~
6 **†† individuals with mental illness and addictive disorders** that
7 is paid for in part or in whole by the state.
8 (5) Make recommendations regarding the commission's findings
9 to the appropriate division or department of state government."
10 Rename all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1020 as introduced.)
