MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on Education, to which was referred Senate Bill 497, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 42, after "to" insert "**the following:**
- 2 **(1) First, to".**
- 3 Page 2, line 42, delete "fees and shall remit the" and insert "**fees.**
- 4 **(2) Second, for fees, books, supplies, and equipment required**
- 5 **for courses of instruction.**
- 6 **The".**
- 7 Page 3, line 1, delete "to the student." and insert "**not used in a**
- 8 **school year does not revert to the student but shall be applied by**
- 9 **the institution to the costs described in subdivisions (1) and (2) that**
- 10 **are incurred by the scholarship recipient in the next school year.**
- 11 **If a scholarship recipient transfers to another approved**
- 12 **postsecondary educational institution before the entire amount of**
- 13 **the scholarship is used, the institution shall transfer the unused**
- 14 **balance to the other institution for use by the scholarship recipient**
- 15 **for the payment of costs described in subdivisions (1) and (2). If a**

1 **scholarship recipient ceases to be a student in good standing at an**
2 **approved postsecondary educational institution with a campus**
3 **located in Indiana and engaged in a program that will lead to an**
4 **approved postsecondary degree or credential, the balance of any**
5 **unused scholarship shall be returned to the commission in**
6 **conformity with the procedures prescribed by the commission."**

7 Page 3, line 2, delete "three" and insert "**the foundation amount (as**
8 **defined in IC 20-43-1-13) that applies to the determination of state**
9 **tuition support distributions in the calendar year in which an early**
10 **graduation scholarship is awarded."**

11 Page 3, delete line 3.
