MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Local Government, to which was referred Senate Bill 60, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 3, after line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 8-22-3-4.1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 4.1. (a) This section
- 4 applies only to the board of an airport authority established for a county
- 5 having a consolidated city.
- 6 (b) The board consists of members appointed as follows:
- 7 (1) The mayor of the consolidated city shall appoint six (6)
- 8 members. Each member appointed under this subdivision must be
- 9 a resident of the county having the consolidated city.
- 10 (2) The ~~board of commissioners~~ **majority leader of the**
- 11 **legislative body** of the county having the consolidated city shall
- 12 appoint one (1) member, **and the minority leader of the**
- 13 **legislative body of the county having the consolidated city**
- 14 **shall appoint one (1) member.** The ~~member~~ members appointed

1 under this subdivision must be a resident of the county having the
2 consolidated city.

3 (3) The county executive of each Indiana county that fulfills all of
4 the following requirements shall each appoint one (1) member:

5 (A) The county is adjacent to the county having the
6 consolidated city.

7 (B) The county has a population of more than one hundred
8 thousand (100,000) but less than one hundred five thousand
9 (105,000).

10 (C) The authority owns real property in the county.

11 The county executive of a county represented on the board under
12 this subdivision may not appoint an advisory member under
13 section 4(e) of this chapter.

14 Not more than four (4) members appointed under ~~subdivisions~~
15 **subdivision (1) and (2)** may be members of the same political party.

16 (c) At least one (1) member of the board appointed under subsection
17 ~~(b)(1)~~ **(b)(2)** must also be a resident of a township that

18 ~~(1) is located in the county having the consolidated city; and~~
19 ~~(2) has a population of:~~

20 ~~(A) less than twenty-five thousand (25,000); or~~

21 ~~(B) more than one hundred thirty-three thousand (133,000) but~~
22 ~~less than one hundred fifty thousand (150,000); is located in~~

23 **the county having a consolidated city and that is a**

24 **township in which the airport is located. If the airport is**

25 **located in more than one (1) township in the county having**

26 **a consolidated city, the second member of the board who**

27 **is appointed under subsection (b)(2) must also be a resident**

28 **of a township that is located in the county having a**

29 **consolidated city and that is a township in which the**

30 **airport is located, but the second member may not be a**

31 **resident of the same township as the first member of the**

32 **board who is appointed under subsection (b)(2).**

33 (d) A member of the board appointed under subsection (b)(3) must
34 be a resident of a township:

35 (1) located in the county making the appointment; and

36 (2) having a population of more than twenty thousand (20,000)

37 but less than twenty-five thousand (25,000).

38 (e) The county executive of a county that is not otherwise

1 represented on the board and that is located not more than one
 2 thousand two hundred (1,200) feet from a certified air carrier airport
 3 that is owned or operated by the authority may appoint one (1) advisory
 4 member to the board. An advisory member appointed under this
 5 subsection:

- 6 (1) must be a resident of:
- 7 (A) the county making the appointment; and
- 8 (B) one (1) of the two (2) townships in the county located
 9 nearest to the airport;
- 10 (2) may not vote on any matter before the board;
- 11 (3) serves at the pleasure of the appointing authority; and
- 12 (4) serves without compensation or payment for expenses.
- 13 (f) A member of the board holds office for four (4) years and until
 14 the member's successor is appointed and qualified.
- 15 (g) If a vacancy occurs in the board, the authority that appointed the
 16 member that vacated the board shall appoint an individual to serve for
 17 the remainder of the unexpired term.
- 18 (h) A board member may be reappointed to successive terms.
- 19 (i) A board member may be impeached under the procedure
 20 provided for the impeachment of county officers.
- 21 (j) A board member appointed under subsection (b)(3) may not vote
 22 on a matter before the board relating to imposing, increasing, or
 23 decreasing property taxes in the county having the consolidated city".
- 24 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
