MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Veterans Affairs and Public Safety, to which was referred House Bill 1406, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 21-17-5-5, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007, SECTION
- 4 258, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 5 1, 2011]: Sec. 5. (a) **This section applies only to a police officer who**
- 6 **meets the minimum basic training and educational requirements**
- 7 **adopted by the law enforcement training board under IC 5-2-1-9**
- 8 **as necessary for employment as a law enforcement officer.**
- 9 (b) **Except as provided in subsection (b);** A police officer appointed
- 10 under this chapter may exercise the powers granted under this chapter
- 11 **only** upon any real property owned or occupied by the educational
- 12 institution employing the police officer, including the streets passing
- 13 through and adjacent to the educational institution. **An institution may**
- 14 **extend a police officer's territorial jurisdiction in accordance with**

1 subsection (c).

2 (c) An institution may extend a police officer's territorial
3 jurisdiction to the entire state, or to any part of the state, if:

4 (1) the board of trustees adopts a resolution specifically
5 describing the territorial jurisdiction of a police officer
6 appointed under this chapter; and

7 (2) the board of trustees notifies the:

8 (A) superintendent of the state police department; and

9 (B) sheriff of the county in which the institution is
10 primarily located (or the chief of police of the consolidated
11 city, if the institution is primarily located in a consolidated
12 city);

13 of the boundaries of the extended territorial jurisdiction.

14 The institution shall provide the persons described in subdivision
15 (2)(A) and (2)(B) with notice of the extended jurisdiction every two
16 (2) years, by January 31 of the second year.

17 (d) If a police officer appointed under this section exercises the
18 officer's police powers outside of the county in which the institution
19 is primarily located, the officer shall notify the sheriff (or, in the
20 case of a consolidated city, the chief of police) as soon as
21 practicable.

22 (b) Additional jurisdiction may be established by agreement with
23 the chief of police of the municipality or sheriff of the county or the
24 appropriate law enforcement agency where the educational institution's
25 property is located, depending upon the jurisdiction involved."

26 Page 1, line 3, after "6." insert "(a)".

27 Page 1, line 4, after "chapter" delete ":" and insert "as follows:".

28 Page 1, line 5, after "(1)" insert "A police officer may exercise the
29 officer's powers".

30 Page 1, line 7, delete "institution;" and insert "institution.".

31 Page 1, line 11, delete "and".

32 Page 1, delete lines 12 through 17, begin a new line block indented
33 and insert:

34 **"(2) This subdivision applies only to a police officer who meets**
35 **the minimum basic training and educational requirements**
36 **adopted by the law enforcement training board under**
37 **IC 5-2-1-9 as necessary for employment as a law enforcement**
38 **officer. An institution may extend a police officer's territorial**

1 **jurisdiction to the entire state, or to any part of the state, if:**
2 **(A) the board of trustees adopts a resolution specifically**
3 **describing the territorial jurisdiction of a police officer**
4 **appointed under this chapter; and**
5 **(B) the board of trustees notifies the:**
6 **(i) superintendent of the state police department; and**
7 **(ii) sheriff of the county in which the institution is**
8 **primarily located (or the chief of police of the**
9 **consolidated city, if the institution is primarily located in**
10 **a consolidated city);**
11 **of the boundaries of the extended territorial jurisdiction.**
12 **The institution shall provide the persons described in clause**
13 **(B)(i) and (B)(ii) with notice of the extended jurisdiction every**
14 **two (2) years, by January 31 of the second year.**
15 **(b) If a police officer appointed under this section exercises the**
16 **officer's police powers outside of the county in which the institution**
17 **is primarily located, the officer shall notify the sheriff (or, in the**
18 **case of a consolidated city, the chief of police) as soon as**
19 **practicable."**
