MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Utilities and Energy, to which was referred Senate Bill 66, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 2, between lines 12 and 13, begin a new line block indented
- 2 and insert:
- 3 **"(12) Coal bed methane derived from a naturally occurring**
- 4 **biogenic process."**
- 5 Page 2, after line 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 2. IC 8-1-31-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 7 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 10. (a) Except as
- 8 provided in subsection (b), a public utility may, but is not required to,
- 9 file a petition for a change in its DSIC not more often than one (1) time
- 10 every ~~twelve (12)~~ **six (6)** months.
- 11 (b) Except as provided in section 15 of this chapter, a public utility
- 12 may not file a petition for a change in its DSIC in the same calendar
- 13 year in which the public utility has filed a request for a general increase
- 14 in the basic rates and charges of the public utility.
- 15 SECTION 3. IC 8-1-31-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 16 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 13. The commission

1 may not approve a DSIC to the extent it would produce total DSIC
2 revenues exceeding ~~five~~ **seven and one-half** percent (~~5%~~) (**7.5%**) of
3 the public utility's base revenue level approved by the commission in
4 the public utility's most recent general rate proceeding.

5 SECTION 4. IC 8-1-31-14 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
6 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 14. The DSIC may be
7 calculated based on a reasonable estimate of sales in the period in
8 which the charge will be in effect. At the end of each twelve (12)
9 month period ~~the charge is in effect,~~ **following the date on which the**
10 **commission initially approves a DSIC for a public utility following**
11 **the public utility's most recent general rate case,** and using
12 procedures approved by the commission, the public utility shall
13 reconcile the difference between DSIC revenues and DSIC costs during
14 ~~that the twelve (12) month~~ period and recover or refund the difference,
15 as appropriate, through adjustment of the charge.".
