MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Elections and Apportionment, to which was referred House Bill 1242, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 5, reset in roman lines 26 through 28.
- 2 Page 12, between lines 37 and 38, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 20. IC 3-8-7-15 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 15. In a special election
- 5 called by the governor, a certificate of nomination may be filed with the
- 6 public official with whom a certificate is required to be filed at any
- 7 time after the election is called but no later than noon ~~fifty (50)~~
- 8 **seventy-four (74)** days before the date of the election."
- 9 Page 16, between lines 20 and 21, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 10 "SECTION 24. IC 3-11-1.5-15.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 11 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 12 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: **Sec. 15.5. If a precinct boundary splits**
- 13 **a census block, either of the following must be submitted with the**
- 14 **order described in section 14 of this chapter:**
- 15 (1) **A description of the precinct boundary in metes and**
- 16 **bounds.**

1 **(2) One (1) or more aerial photographs that depict:**

2 **(A) each census block that is split; and**

3 **(B) the boundary of the precinct that splits each census**
4 **block."**

5 Page 22, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:

6 "SECTION 35. IC 3-13-1-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
7 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 8. A meeting under
8 section 7 of this chapter shall be called and chaired by:

9 (1) the state chairman, or a person designated by the state
10 chairman, for a caucus or committee acting under section 3, 4, 5,
11 or 6(b) of this chapter; or

12 (2) the county chairman of the county in which the greatest
13 percentage of the population of the election district is located, **or**
14 **an individual designated by the county chairman**, for a caucus
15 or committee acting under section 6(a) of this chapter.

16 SECTION 36. IC 3-13-1-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
17 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 9. The call for a
18 meeting under section 7 of this chapter must:

19 (1) be in writing on a form prescribed by the commission;

20 (2) state the name of the chairman of the meeting;

21 (3) state the purpose of the meeting;

22 (4) state the date, time, and place of the meeting;

23 (5) be sent by first class mail, at least ten (10) days before the
24 meeting, to all persons eligible to participate in the meeting; and

25 (6) be filed **at least not later than noon** ten (10) days before the
26 meeting with the official who is required to receive a certificate
27 of candidate selection following the caucus under section 15 of
28 this chapter."

29 Page 22, between lines 35 and 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:

30 "SECTION 39. IC 3-13-1-15 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
31 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 15. (a) A county
32 chairman filling a candidate vacancy under section 6(a)(2) of this
33 chapter or the chairman of a meeting filling a candidate vacancy under
34 this chapter shall file a written certificate of candidate selection on a
35 form prescribed by the commission stating the following information
36 for each candidate selected:

37 (1) The name of each candidate as:

38 (A) the candidate wants the candidate's name to appear on the

- 1 ballot; and
- 2 (B) the candidate's name is permitted to appear on the ballot
- 3 under IC 3-5-7.
- 4 (2) The residence address of each candidate.
- 5 (b) The certificate shall be filed with:
- 6 (1) the election division for:
- 7 (A) a committee acting under section 3, 4, 5, or 6(b) of this
- 8 chapter; or
- 9 (B) a committee acting under section 6(a) of this chapter to fill
- 10 a candidate vacancy in the office of judge of a circuit, superior,
- 11 probate, county, or small claims court or prosecuting attorney;
- 12 or
- 13 (2) the circuit court clerk, for a committee acting under section
- 14 6(a) of this chapter to fill a candidate vacancy for a local office
- 15 not described in subdivision (1).
- 16 (c) This subsection applies to a candidate vacancy resulting from a
- 17 vacancy on the primary election ballot as described in section 2 of this
- 18 chapter. The certificate required by subsection (a) shall be filed not
- 19 later than noon July 3 before election day.
- 20 (d) This subsection applies to all candidate vacancies not described
- 21 by subsection (c). The certificate required by subsection (a) shall be
- 22 filed not ~~more~~ later than ~~noon~~ three (3) days (excluding Saturdays and
- 23 Sundays) after selection of the candidates."
- 24 Page 23, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 25 "SECTION 41. IC 3-13-11-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 26 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 6. The county
- 27 chairman:
- 28 (1) of the county in which the greatest percentage of the
- 29 population of the election district is located; and
- 30 (2) of the same political party that elected or selected the official
- 31 who vacated the office to be filled;

1 **(or an individual designated by the county chairman)** is the
2 chairman of a caucus held under this chapter. The chairman is not
3 eligible to vote in the caucus unless the chairman is also a member of
4 the caucus."

5 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1242 as introduced.)
