
SENATE BILL No. 101

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-24; IC 9-26-1-1.5.

Synopsis: Driver education issues. Authorizes the bureau of motor vehicles (bureau) to issue a learner's permit to a person at least 15 years of age under certain conditions. (Current law authorizes the bureau to issue a learner's permit to a person at least 15 years and 180 days of age.) Provides that, effective July 1, 2011, an individual who has not passed an approved driver education course must: (1) be at least 17 years and 180 days of age; and (2) have held a valid learner's permit for at least 180 days in order to receive an operator's license.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-24-3-2.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.101-2009,
2 SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2.5. ~~(a) This section applies beginning July 1,~~
4 ~~2010.~~

5 ~~(b)~~ Except as provided in section 3 of this chapter, an individual
6 must satisfy the requirements set forth in one (1) of the following
7 subdivisions to receive an operator's license:

- 8 (1) The individual meets the following conditions:
 - 9 (A) Is at least sixteen (16) years and one hundred eighty (180)
 - 10 days of age.
 - 11 (B) Has held a valid learner's permit for at least one hundred
 - 12 eighty (180) days.
 - 13 (C) Obtains an instructor's certification that the individual has
 - 14 satisfactorily completed an approved driver education course.
 - 15 (D) Passes the required examination.
 - 16 (E) Completes at least fifty (50) hours of supervised driving
 - 17 practice, of which at least ten (10) hours are nighttime driving,

- 4 (ii) the spouse of the individual who is at least twenty-one

- 15 (i) a licensed instructor or a licensed driver who is at least

- 17 (ii) the spouse of the individual who is at least twenty-one
- 18 (21) years of age.
- 19 **This subdivision expires June 30, 2011.**
- 20 **(3) Effective July 1, 2011, the individual meets the following**
- 21 **conditions:**
- 22 **(A) Is at least seventeen (17) years and one hundred eighty**
- 23 **(180) days of age.**
- 24 **(B) Has held a valid learner's permit for at least one**
- 25 **hundred eighty (180) days.**
- 26 **(C) Passes the required examination.**
- 27 **(D) Completes at least fifty (50) hours of supervised**
- 28 **driving practice, of which at least ten (10) hours are**
- 29 **nighttime driving, with:**
- 30 **(i) a licensed instructor or a licensed driver who is at**
- 31 **least twenty-five (25) years of age; or**
- 32 **(ii) the spouse of the individual who is at least twenty-one**
- 33 **(21) years of age.**
- 34 **(4) The individual meets the following conditions:**
- 35 **(A) Is at least sixteen (16) years and one hundred eighty (180)**
- 36 **days of age but less than eighteen (18) years of age.**
- 37 **(B) Has previously been a nonresident of Indiana, but, at the**
- 38 **time of application, qualifies as an Indiana resident.**
- 39 **(C) Holds an unrevoked driver's license, excluding a learner's**
- 40 **permit or the equivalent, in the state or a combination of states**
- 41 **in which the individual formerly resided for at least one**
- 42 **hundred eighty (180) days.**

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- 1 (D) Passes the required examination.
- 2 ~~(4)~~ (5) The individual meets the following conditions:
- 3 (A) Is at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- 4 (B) Has previously been a nonresident of Indiana but, at the
- 5 time of application, qualifies as an Indiana resident.
- 6 (C) Has held an unrevoked operator's, chauffeur's, commercial
- 7 driver's, or public passenger chauffeur's license from the state
- 8 of prior residence.
- 9 (D) Passes the required examination.

10 SECTION 2. IC 9-24-7-1.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 11 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 12 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 1.1. The bureau shall issue a learner's**
 13 **permit to an individual who meets the following conditions:**

- 14 (1) **Is at least fifteen (15) years of age.**
- 15 (2) **If less than eighteen (18) years of age, is not ineligible**
 16 **under IC 9-24-2-1.**
- 17 (3) **Is enrolled in an approved driver education course.**

18 SECTION 3. IC 9-24-7-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 19 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2. The bureau shall validate a
 20 learner's permit issued under section ~~1.1~~ of this chapter (**or section**
 21 **1 of this chapter before its repeal**) upon certification by the instructor
 22 of an approved driver education course that the holder has satisfactorily
 23 completed the course.

24 SECTION 4. IC 9-26-1-1.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.126-2008,
 25 SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 26 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1.5. (a) If:

- 27 (1) the driver of a vehicle is physically incapable of determining
- 28 the need for or rendering assistance to any injured or entrapped
- 29 person as required under section 1(2)(C) of this chapter;
- 30 (2) there is another occupant in the vehicle at the time of the
- 31 accident who is:
- 32 (A) at least:
- 33 (i) fifteen (15) years of age and holds a learner's permit
- 34 issued under IC 9-24-7-1 **before its repeal or IC 9-24-7-1.1**
- 35 or a driver's license issued under IC 9-24-11; or
- 36 (ii) eighteen (18) years of age; and
- 37 (B) capable of determining the need for and rendering
- 38 reasonable assistance to injured or entrapped persons as
- 39 provided in section 1(2)(C) of this chapter; and
- 40 (3) the other occupant in the vehicle knows that the driver of the
- 41 vehicle is physically incapable of determining the need for or
- 42 rendering assistance to any injured or entrapped person;

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1 the vehicle occupant referred to in subdivisions (2) and (3) shall
2 immediately determine the need for and render reasonable assistance
3 to each person injured or entrapped in the accident as provided in
4 section 1(2)(C) of this chapter.

- 5 (b) If:
 - 6 (1) the driver of a vehicle is physically incapable of giving
 - 7 immediate notice of an accident as required under section 1(3) of
 - 8 this chapter;
 - 9 (2) there is another occupant in the vehicle at the time of the
 - 10 accident who is:
 - 11 (A) at least:
 - 12 (i) fifteen (15) years of age and holds a learner's permit
 - 13 issued under IC 9-24-7-1 **before its repeal or IC 9-24-7-1.1**
 - 14 or a driver's license issued under IC 9-24-11; or
 - 15 (ii) eighteen (18) years of age; and
 - 16 (B) capable of giving notice as provided in section 1(3) of this
 - 17 chapter; and
 - 18 (3) the other occupant in the vehicle knows that the driver of the
 - 19 vehicle is physically incapable of giving immediate notice of an
 - 20 accident;

21 the vehicle occupant referred to in subdivisions (2) and (3) shall
22 immediately give notice of the accident by the quickest means of
23 communication as provided in section 1(3) of this chapter.

24 (c) If there is more than one (1) vehicle occupant to whom
25 subsection (a) applies, it is a defense to a prosecution of one (1) vehicle
26 occupant under subsection (a) that the defendant reasonably believed
27 that another occupant of the vehicle determined the need for and
28 rendered reasonable assistance as required under subsection (a).

29 (d) If there is more than one (1) vehicle occupant to whom
30 subsection (b) applies, it is a defense to a prosecution of one (1) vehicle
31 occupant under subsection (b) that the defendant reasonably believed
32 that another occupant of the vehicle gave the notice required under
33 subsection (b).

34 SECTION 5. IC 9-24-7-1 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE UPON
35 PASSAGE].

36 SECTION 6. **An emergency is declared for this act.**

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
