DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 3-14-1-10.5; IC 33-33-2-11.

Synopsis: Allen superior court elections. Removes provision that prohibits a judge or candidate for judge of the Allen superior court from accepting more than \$10,000 in contributions from all sources to pay expenses connected with the judge's or candidate's candidacy. Repeals penalty provision for violating that provision.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-33-2-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 11. A judge or
 3 candidate for judge of the Allen superior court may not
 4 (†) accept a contribution (as defined in IC 3-5-2-15) from any
 5 political party, political action committee (as defined in
 6 IC 3-5-2-37), or regular party committee (as defined in
 7 IC 3-5-2-42). ~~or~~
 8 (‡) accept more than a total of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in
 9 contributions from all sources to pay expenses connected with the
 10 candidate's candidacy.
 11 SECTION 2. IC 3-14-1-10.5 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
 12 1, 2011].
