DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-28-11-4.

Synopsis: Unused medication. Allows a county jail or a department of correction facility to return unused medication to the pharmacy that dispensed it.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

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SENATE BILL No. 177

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-28-11-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.204-2005,
2 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 4. A health facility, **county jail, or department**
4 **of correction facility** that possesses unused medication that meets the
5 requirements of IC 25-26-13-25(j)(1) through IC 25-26-13-25(j)(6):
6 (1) shall return medication that belonged to a Medicaid recipient;
7 and
8 (2) may return other unused medication;
9 to the pharmacy that dispensed the medication.
