

## SENATE BILL No. 245

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### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-41-16.5.

**Synopsis:** Prenatal substance abuse commission. Creates the prenatal substance abuse commission and requires the commission to develop and recommend a coordinated plan to improve early intervention and treatment for pregnant women who abuse alcohol or drugs or use tobacco. (The commission was originally created in 2007 and expired December 31, 2009.)

**Effective:** Upon passage.

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## SENATE BILL No. 245

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-41-16.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 UPON PASSAGE]:

4 **Chapter 16.5. Prevention and Treatment Programs: Prenatal**  
5 **Substance Abuse Commission**

6 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to the**  
7 **prenatal substance abuse commission established by section 2 of**  
8 **this chapter.**

9 **Sec. 2. The prenatal substance abuse commission is established**  
10 **to develop and recommend a coordinated plan to improve early**  
11 **intervention and treatment for pregnant women who:**

- 12 (1) **abuse alcohol or drugs; or**
- 13 (2) **use tobacco.**

14 **Sec. 3. The commission consists of the following members:**

- 15 (1) **The state health commissioner or the commissioner's**  
16 **designee.**
- 17 (2) **The director of the division of mental health and addiction**  
18 **or the director's designee.**



- 1           **(3) The director of the office of Medicaid policy and planning**
- 2           **or the director's designee.**
- 3           **(4) The director of the department of child services or the**
- 4           **director's designee.**
- 5           **(5) One (1) physician specializing in addiction treatment of**
- 6           **pregnant women.**
- 7           **(6) One (1) physician specializing in the care of pregnant**
- 8           **women.**
- 9           **(7) One (1) social worker certified in the treatment of alcohol,**
- 10          **tobacco, and other drug abuse.**
- 11          **(8) One (1) woman who has received treatment for alcohol,**
- 12          **tobacco, or other drug abuse during pregnancy.**
- 13          **(9) One (1) advocate recommended by the March of Dimes,**
- 14          **Indiana Chapter.**
- 15          **(10) One (1) prosecuting attorney or a deputy prosecuting**
- 16          **attorney who practices in a problem solving court established**
- 17          **under IC 33-23-16.**
- 18          **(11) One (1) judge of a problem solving court established**
- 19          **under IC 33-23-16.**
- 20          **(12) Two (2) members of the house of representatives, who are**
- 21          **nonvoting members. The members appointed under this**
- 22          **subdivision may not be members of the same political party.**
- 23          **(13) Two (2) members of the senate, who are nonvoting**
- 24          **members. The members appointed under this subdivision may**
- 25          **not be members of the same political party.**
- 26          **(14) An advanced practice nurse who has a collaborative**
- 27          **agreement with a physician who specializes in addiction**
- 28          **treatment for pregnant women or the care of pregnant**
- 29          **women.**

30           **The speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint the**  
 31           **members under subdivisions (5), (7), (9), (10), and (12) not later**  
 32           **than July 1, 2011. The president pro tempore of the senate shall**  
 33           **appoint the members under subdivisions (6), (8), (11), (13), and (14)**  
 34           **not later than July 1, 2011. Vacancies shall be filled by the**  
 35           **appointing authority for the remainder of an unexpired term.**

36           **Sec. 4. A majority of the voting members of the commission**  
 37           **constitutes a quorum.**

38           **Sec. 5. The state department shall provide staff and**  
 39           **administrative support for the commission.**

40           **Sec. 6. The state health commissioner or the commissioner's**  
 41           **designee shall convene the first meeting of the commission before**  
 42           **September 1, 2011. The commission shall elect a member of the**

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1 commission to serve as chairperson of the commission. The  
2 commission shall meet at the call of the chairperson and shall meet  
3 as often as necessary to carry out the purpose of this chapter.  
4 However, the commission shall meet at least quarterly.

5 Sec. 7. Members of the commission are not entitled to a salary  
6 per diem or reimbursement of expenses for service on the  
7 commission.

8 Sec. 8. The affirmative votes of a majority of the commission's  
9 voting members are required for the commission to take action on  
10 any measure.

11 Sec. 9. The commission shall submit reports to the governor and  
12 the legislative council as follows:

13 (1) Not later than December 15, 2012, an interim report that  
14 contains any interim findings and recommendations of the  
15 commission.

16 (2) Not later than December 15, 2013, a final report that  
17 contains the findings and recommendations of the commission  
18 and an implementation plan to improve early intervention  
19 and treatment for pregnant women who abuse alcohol or  
20 drugs or use tobacco.

21 The reports required under this section must be submitted in an  
22 electronic format under IC 5-14-6.

23 Sec. 10. This chapter expires June 30, 2014.

24 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.

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
